



## LONG TERM CARE (LTC) SERVICES

<b>SoonerCare (Medicaid)</b>	
<p><b>State Plan Personal Care</b></p> <p><b>Financial eligibility</b></p>	<p>Assistance to a person in meeting daily living needs such as bathing, grooming, meal preparation, light housekeeping, and laundry.</p> <p>Income cannot exceed \$931 per month for an individual or \$1,261 for married couples; resources cannot exceed \$6,940 for an individual or \$10,410 for married couples.</p>
<p><b>ADvantage Program</b></p> <p><b>Financial eligibility</b></p>	<p>A variety of services are offered in the home of the frail older person or adult with physical disabilities as an alternative to institutional care. Services include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• personal care</li> <li>• advanced supportive/restorative assistance</li> <li>• nursing care</li> <li>• environmental modification of own property</li> <li>• medication</li> <li>• medical equipment/supplies</li> <li>• adult day health care (ADH): personal care and therapy</li> <li>• case management</li> <li>• home delivered meals</li> <li>• therapies: OT, PT, RT, speech, language</li> <li>• hospice</li> <li>• respite</li> <li>• assisted living</li> </ul> <p>Income cannot exceed \$2,094 per month; resources cannot exceed \$2,000.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For additional information on resources, see Appendix A-8 (02AX005E) or contact your local OKDHS human services center (HSC).</li> <li>• New applicants call 1-800-435-4711 for Personal Care or ADvantage program services.</li> <li>• Existing SoonerCare (Medicaid) clients contact your local OKDHS HSC to access these services.</li> </ul>

<b>SoonerCare (Medicaid)</b>	
<b>Nursing facility</b>	For persons who require 24-hour assistance from professional staff to meet daily living needs.
<b>Financial eligibility</b>	Income cannot exceed \$2,094 per month; resources cannot exceed \$2,000. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For further information on resources, see Appendix A-8 (02AX005E) or contact your local OKDHS HSC.</li> </ul>

<b>Social Services Block Grant (Title XX)</b>	
<b>Adult day services</b>	Service to a person in a community center, usually five days per week for six - eight hours, offering meals, socialization, therapies, medication administration, and recreational activities. This program is not for ADvantage members. ADvantage members are served through adult day health care in their service plan.
<b>Financial eligibility</b>	Income cannot exceed \$2,083 per month for an individual; for married couples income is added together then halved before comparing to the standard. Resources are not considered. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monthly co-payments are based on a sliding scale. See Appendix M-105 (02AX010E).</li> </ul>
