



### **Permit to Drill D.A.G.**

- 1) The permit to drill D.A.G. shall be valid only for one or more deep groundbeds within the designated 10 acre governmental track.
- 2) Any contractor drilling a deep anode groundbed shall be licensed with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board.
- 3) The permit to drill D.A.G. shall expire six (6) months after date of issuance, unless drilling operations are commenced.
- 4) A copy of the permit shall be maintained at the site and shall be made available for inspection.
- 5) The district manager or field inspector shall be notified at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance, prior to commencing drilling operations.
- 6) The district office or field inspector shall be notified within twenty-four (24) hours of any failure to comply with the approved construction requirements.
- 7) In the event the hole is lost during drilling the hole will be plugged as soon as possible.

**Any operator who drills a deep anode groundbed without a permit shall be subject to a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).**
