Introduction

The Oklahoma Department of Libraries uses an alpha-numeric designation to classify Oklahoma state government publications. This notation is assigned to the keyword of each state government agency or sub-state planning district in order to avoid confusing the statutory name with the colloquial name (e.g., Oklahoma Department of Libraries vs. State Library). This practice results in an alphabetic arrangement by agency name, which facilitates retrieval of information. Likewise, the use of form divisions keeps similar publications of an agency together, increasing shelf accessibility and use (e.g. annual reports, handbooks, and newsletters each have their own form division).

The three-figure Cutter table, with workmarks as necessary, is applied to the title of each publication to obtain a distinct classification number for each publication.

This publication is a condensed and revised version of *Oklahoma State Documents Classification and List of Oklahoma State Agencies from Statehood to the Present*, issued 1980.

Current agencies are listed in A-Z call number order.

Following the current agencies are call numbers used for agencies no longer in existence. Some publications of these agencies are included in the collection of the Oklahoma Publications Clearinghouse.

For agencies with class numbers for divisions: many division names change over the years, some divisions no longer in existence. All numbers for an agency are grouped in the main listing.

For agencies prior to 1978: Oklahoma Documents classification numbers were assigned in: *Oklahoma State Documents Classification and List of Oklahoma State Agencies from Statehood to the Present*, Oklahoma Publications Clearinghouse, 1980.

Some numbers appearing in earlier editions of this Classification do not appear in the A-Z of agencies or the listing of former agency call numbers; no publications from these agencies have been received by the Oklahoma Publications Clearinghouse.

Oklahoma State Government Publications Classification Schedule Guidelines

A. Selection of Classification Number

Classify publications under the name of the agency as it existed at the time of publication. When an agency name change occurs, a new entry will be made in the classification scheme with instructions to use either the old classification number or a newly assigned one.

Classify studies prepared by agencies other than the issuing agency or by private companies with the contracting agency. *[The cataloging entry will reflect the author agency.]*

Classify cooperative research projects authored by several agencies with the coordinating agency.

Classify federal state cooperative publications with the major or first named cooperating state agency.

Classify interstate compacts for which a commissioner or commission has been established under its own number. Those compacts administered by an existing agency are classified with the administering agency as indicated in the classification.

Governing boards directing the policy of an agency as their sole function are classified with agency governed.

B. Selection of Form Division

Select for content (.1 .5) before format (.6 .8).

Never force a publication into a form division. When in doubt, use .8 for monographs.

Additional information for treatment of the publications of particular agencies are included with notes for the agency.

C. Selection of Cutter Number

Cutter for the title, omitting common words like Oklahoma, state, department, etc. *[generally applies to form divisions .2, .3, .4, .6, .8].*

Cutter for the subject when there are multiple works, not series, that should be held together, or when so instructed *[generally applies to form division .5]*

Cutter for the series title when using form division “.7.”

D. Use of Dates and Numbers in Call Numbers

Add the year to the call number for editions and revisions. The year is the year published or the year(s) of coverage.

For annual reports covering the calendar year, use the calendar year covered, not the date published.

For annual and/or biennial reports covering the fiscal year(s), indicate the year(s) covered, not the year published (e.g., 1997/98 or 1999/00).

For serials classified .6, add the volume and issue number of the publication to the call number (e.g., vol. 1, no. 1).

When adding a draft of a report or document add "d" after the year (e.g., 2001d).

For publications revised in the same year as original, add "r" after year (e.g., 1998r).
For publications revised in a different year than original, but contents reflect original year, add year revised after original year (e.g., 1996r1998).

- [content] .3 Departmental Reports**
Includes annual and biennial reports, state plans, annual program plans, financial reports, audits issued by other than the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, reports requested by legislation or as a result of special committee, surveys.
- [content] .4 Laws**
Includes policies, rules, regulations, standards, proposed legislation.
- [content] .5 Guides**
Includes handbooks, manuals, directories, bibliographies, catalogs, curriculum guides.
- [content] .6 Serials**
Includes magazines, newspapers, newsletters.
- [format] .7 Series**
Cutter for series title.
- [format] .8 Monographs**
Histories. Class here studies (as contrasted to reports which are .3)
- [special] .9 Special Designation**
Use for items not easily placed in other form divisions. Audio-visual publications. Maps.
