

PROJECT 1 Fish Hatchery Operations and Maintenance

OBJECTIVE: To maintain and operate four state fish hatcheries to produce and stock 11 million fish (black basses, sunfish, catfish, walleye, saugeye, striped bass and hybrid bass), annually, in Oklahoma waters to maintain 19 million angler-days recreational fishing opportunity.

Operations and Maintenance at the Byron State Fish Hatchery (Alfalfa County), Durant State Fish Hatchery (Bryan County), Holdenville State Fish Hatchery (Hughes County) and James A. Manning State Fish Hatchery (Comanche County) was maintained. Engineering was completed and the bid process started on the Byron State Fish Hatchery repair project in 2009 and Project completed in 2010. In 2010, the process was started to hire an engineer for the Durant State Fish Hatchery Repair Project.
