HB2309 Principal Author(s): Deutschendorf, Abe; Long, Lewis Jr. Allows school districts to employ teachers or allow teachers under contract to teach a grade level or a curricular area in which the teacher is not licensed on a temporary basis to accommodate increases and decreases in student population for no longer than 1 semester. The teacher will be required to hold a valid certificate or be licensed in the teaching profession. Unlicensed personnel may monitor interactive video instructional programs or classes taught through distance learning technology.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2310 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd Modifies language pertaining to the Plumbing License Law of 1955. Defines the terms 'plumbing contractor' and 'journeyman plumber technician'.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2322 Principal Author(s): Smith, Dale Exempts the purchase of used transportation equipment from certain school transportation equipment purchase requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2332 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Williams, Penny Recodifies the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Human Resources (S)

HB2360 Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E. Directs the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Tax Commission to conduct a study relating to the regulation and licensing of jet ski and boat operators in the state; requires a report of the findings to be submitted to the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Governor.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2369 Principal Author(s): Staggs, Barbara Makes days for in-person absentee voting uniform for all elections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Rules (S)

HB2371 Principal Author(s): Staggs, Barbara States that compensation received for jury duty shall be exempt from taxable income.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Engrossed - House

HB2373 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2374 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari Creates the Workplace and Employee Protection Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2375 Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Douglass, Brooks States that if a juvenile offender fails to complete assigned community service within a specified time, the child may be found in contempt of court; states that if child is found in contempt, the parent or guardian and the child shall share the same cell for a period of up to 48 hours.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2393 Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark Creates the Early Identification and Service Support for Children and Families Act; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth; provides for the results of early screening procedures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2407 Principal Author(s): Deutschendorf, Abe; Maddox, James R. Specifies the purpose of the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program to improve the quality of life and the quality of care of elderly citizens residing in long-term care facilities in Oklahoma.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2428 Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill; Smith, Jerry L. Modifies, merges, and consolidates duplicative language pertaining to DHS, Health Care Authority, OSBI, courts, basic health benefits boards, etc.; Emergency. Enrolled - House

HB2430 Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill Amends language pertaining to workers' compensation equivalent insurance products.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2448 Principal Author(s): Maddux, Elmer L. Relates to the disposal of lands under the jurisdiction of the Commissioners of the Land Office. Stipulates that appraisers must be appointed by the Commissioners of the Land Office.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - House

HB2453 Principal Author(s): Case, Bill; Herbert, Dave Modifies statutory references relating to the supervision of children. Deletes various juvenile crimes as they relate to municipalities. Defines the term 'district attorney'.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Judiciary (S)

HB2471 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Herbert, Dave Requires only state agencies, (excludes boards and commissions) to furnish copies of financial audits, compliance audits, and program reviews to the Office of State Finance, the State Auditor and Inspector and the Legislative Services Bureau. Deletes language regarding the Legislative Service Bureau providing copies to legislative leadership.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Appropriations (S)

HB2473 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Fisher, Ted V. Amends language relating to the assessment and valuation of property. States if property is not leased within the year prior to January 1 of the initial assessment year, the county assessor will assess the improvements based on the fair market value of the property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2482 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Standardizes fur dealer's fee to \$68.00 for residents and nonresidents.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2494 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Vaughn, Ray Modifies sections of the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act relevant to age of purchaser of tobacco products. Provides penalties.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, General Government (S)

HB2501 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J. Modifies powers and duties of the Department of Human Services, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Oklahoma Medicaid Program Integrity Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2516 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Toure, Opio Modifies the time period in which a court may modify a sentence or revocation of probation from 120 days to 180 days; provides for continuing jurisdiction.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Judiciary (S)

HB2550 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Deletes statutory reference relating to barbers.; Effective Date: 09/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - House
