HB2822 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Establishes appropriations from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury to the State Board of Education and the Department of Human Services.; Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

HB2823 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Provides midterm supplements to the State Board of Education State Aid to education for the 1995-96 school year.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Appropriations (S)

HB2824 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Establishes appropriations to the State Board of Education for midterm supplements to State Aid to school districts.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Appropriations (S)

HB2857 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Provides that the production of oil from each marginal well in the state producing three (3) barrels of oil or less per day shall be exempt from gross production tax.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2867 Principal Author(s): Perry, Fred Deletes county reporting requirement for consumption or disposal of consumable items other than road or bridge items.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2874 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies definitions to include natural gas; increases the membership of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board from eighteen (18) to thirty (30); decreases membership of said board to twenty-four (24) after Jul. 1, 1996 and provides for reapportionment of members; modifies the assessment to be levied for board funding from two cents per barrel (\$0.02) to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the gross revenues received at the wellhead for oil, natural gas, casinghead gas or condensate; increases amount retained by the board from One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000).; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. HB2899 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Modifies the powers, duties and responsibilities of the Oklahoma International Trade Development Council.; Emergency. Engrossed - House

HB2923 Principal Author(s): Sadler, Al Requires payments for injury to certain property to be made payable to both claimant and either lienholder or secured party by means of a negotiable instrument.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2933 Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R. Revises schedule of cash benefits to AFDC recipients. Provides determination of ineligibility. Requires submission of federal waiver requests, and prohibits implementation until certain certification criteria is met.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2934 Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R.; Stipe, Gene Modifies definitions relating to the Health Care Freedom of Choice Act. Requires certain policies be brought into compliance and clarifies compliance.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2937 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Stipe, Gene Modifies permissible duration of contracts with private prison contractors and provides limitations.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Appropriations (S)

HB2939 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Ford, Charles R. Modifies criteria for composition and selection of members to the Board of Juvenile Affairs.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2954 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Clarifies and updates language relating to the manner of disposal of land.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - House

HB2957 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Staggs, Barbara Stipulates that it is unlawful and punishable for any person to operate a water vessel while under the influence of any intoxicant or has a blood or breath alcohol concentration of 0.10.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2964 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Clarifies legislative intent relevant to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Development Disabilities Act.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2971 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ Clarifies language pertaining to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Distinguishes adopted children from biological children with regard to beneficiaries.; Emergency. Engrossed - House

HB2980 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ Modifies language and definitions relating to the Oklahoma Adoption Act; making Indian Tribes subject to the Subsidized Adoption Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2983 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ Establishes that medical history and social history forms shall be kept as part of permanent court records in cases of adoption; states who is authorized to view said records; provides direction for distribution and release of said records.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2988 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Authorizes the State Board of Agriculture to establish fees; provides for other surety allowable for livestock markets by the US Packers and Stockyards Act; and provides penalties upon the suspension, revocation, or expiration of livestock auction market licenses.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB2989 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Creates the Livestock Dealers Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HB3000 Principal Author(s): Gray, Charles; Rubottom, Don Declares 'Oklahoma My Native Land' the official children's song of the state.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred Direct To Calendar, General Order - Senate

HB3013 Principal Author(s): Sullivan, Leonard; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Adds the Minority Leaders of the House of Representatives and the Senate to the board membership of Oklahoma Futures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB3028 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Wilkerson, Dick States that any written bill of sale, timber deed or timber contract shall be preserved by the owner or operator of a logging or timber harvesting operation for at least a period of three (3) years.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB3037 Principal Author(s): Perry, Fred Requires environmental agencies to promulgate rules to establish penalties to be imposed against any person who knowingly makes a false complaint or who knowingly misrepresents or omits material information relating to the complaint.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Engrossed - House

HCR1059 Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Authorizes the Board of Regents for the University of Oklahoma acting on behalf of Cameron University to issue revenue bonds.; Engrossed - House
