SB 723 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Pope, Clay Increases advanced accreditation standard for county assessors from twenty (20) hours per year to thirty (30) hours every three (3) years.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Revenue & Taxation (H)

SB 727 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Vaughn, Ray Modifies language relating to the Uniform Tax Procedure Code to include judgments; clarifies statutory reference.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Revenue & Taxation (H)

SB 729 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Sullivan, Leonard Modifies language relating to licensure of used motor vehicle dealers and manufactured home dealers; modifies insurance requirements.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Public Safety (H)

SB 730 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Fisher, Ted V. Modifies language and statutory references relating to assessment and valuation of property; requires county assessors to assess specified improvements based on fair market value.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

SB 733 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Paulk, William R. Modifies statutory reference relating to the Oklahoma Town Meeting Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, County & Municipal Govt (H)

SB 752 Principal Author(s): Ford, Charles R.; Holt, James D. Modifies language relating to special license plates; creates a United States Air Force Association License Plate.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Public Safety (H)

SB 777 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Provides for the reimbursement for persons engaging in voluntary cleanup programs.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

SB 779 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Provides that each member of the board of directors of the Grand River Dam Authority shall receive a fee of \$75 for each day spent in attending meetings of the Board and attending to authorized business of the district; allows said authority to implement compensation adjustments to correct internal inequities as determined by the board of directors.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Energy Environment & Nat Res (H)

SB 786 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave Authorizes Oklahoma Real Estate Commission to prescribe fees by rule. Removes the power of the Commission to have jurisdiction over persons who are no longer licensed. Requires persons who have active management control over persons required to be licensed to also possess a license as a real estate broker.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Banking & Finance (H)

SB 837 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds for the expenses of various agencies of the executive, legislative and judicial branches of the state including, but not limited to, the State Arts Council, the State Board of Education, the State Regents, the Department of Libraries, the Board of Private Vocational Schools, OCAST, the State VoTech Board, the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, the Ethics Commission, the Election Board, and offices of the Governor, the House of Representatives, the Legislative Service Bureau, OMPC, OPM, the Tax Commission, the Office of the Treasurer and others.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. Engrossed - House

SB 856 Principal Author(s): Gustafson, Bill; Stites, J. T. Modifies language relating to rewards, maximum amounts for rewards and requirements for certain funds to revert to general fund.; Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB 859 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Williams, Don Includes weather modification in a list of designated purposes for county sales tax.; Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB 867 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Creates the Oklahoma Barbers Regulation Act.; Effective Date: 09/01/96. Engrossed - Senate

SB 869 Principal Author(s): Haney, Enoch Kelly; Steidley, Dwayne Requires the Director of the Office of State Finance to make copies of all agency budget work programs and notice of budget work program revisions to the Joint Legislative Committee on Budget and Program Oversight.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB 875 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Capps, Gilmer N. Provides additional powers and duties to the authority of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Energy Environment & Nat Res (H)

SB 888 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Authorizes payment for a Medicare risk sharing contract for participating members of the Oklahoma State and Education Employees Group Insurance system.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB 890 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Thomas, Tommy Specifies portion of premium tax assessed on the premiums of Medicaid recipients be deposited in the Medicaid Contingency Revolving Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Appropriations & Budget (H)

SB 896 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Transfers various powers and authorities of the State Employees Benefits Council from the Health Care Authority to the Council itself.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Public Health (H)

SB 900 Principal Author(s): Maddux, Elmer L.; Muegge, Paul; Price, Bruce Extends date of acceptance of applications for tuition waivers for farmers and ranchers from 1996 to 2006.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB 905 Principal Author(s): Littlefield, Rick; Roberts, Larry D. Extends benefits of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System to spouses married continuously for the 36 months immediately preceding the member's death.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Retirement Laws (H)

SB 922 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Transfers the State Employee Assistance Program from the Office of Personnel Management to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board effective 07-01-96.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB 933 Principal Author(s): Ferguson, Larry R.; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Requires registration of tax warrants; provides that registration constitute evidence and notice; and requires that all tax warrants be filed with the Oklahoma Tax Commission.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Revenue & Taxation (H)

SB 941 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Clarifies language pertaining to the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Retirement Laws (H)
