SB1061 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Judiciary (H)

SB1062 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for the establishment of a crimes information unit within the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Criminal Justice (H)

SB1070 Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Steidley, Dwayne Authorizes boards of education to enter into contracts for the purpose of implementing energy conservation measures designed to reduce the energy consumption or operating costs of school facilities.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB1150 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Lengthens amount of time needed before the arrested is brought before a court from 24 to 48 hours. Modifies procedures for an arresting peace officer and the subsequent actions that must be undertaken.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Criminal Justice (H)

SB1163 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Changes name of act of 'Educational Deregulation Act' to 'Oklahoma Trailblazer Schools and School Districts Act.' Removes some requirements for eligibility for deregulation, states limits for deregulation, provides limitation of number of districts and school sites that may be deregulated.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB1178 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Modifies qualifications of the Chief Medical Examiner; provides that the Chief Med Examiner serve at the pleasure of the Board; establishes procedures for production of certain materials; authorizes fee for storage of biological specimens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1179 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Maddox, James R. Modifies the date by which franchise tax statements must be filed with the Oklahoma Tax Commission to correspond with the filing of annual income tax returns.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1184 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Kerr, Robert M. Expands offenses eligible for reverse certification.; Emergency. Engrossed - Senate

SB1185 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. Allows for destruction of all paper records that have been microfilmed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1192 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Herbert, Dave Creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Act; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Advisory Committee within the Department of Transportation; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Revolving Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Transportation (H)

SB1200 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick Authorizes the establishment of drug courts in the district courts of the state; provides for funding.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Criminal Justice (H)

SB1207 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Authorizes the Department of Human Services to give consent for medical examinations and tests and the release of test results to placement providers.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Children Youth & Family Svcs (H)

SB1223 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. States that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall have the power and duty to, in conjunction with the Oklahoma Medicaid Healthcare options system, review and evaluate State Medicaid Program eligibility and enrollment guidelines in relation to federal regulations.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1224 Principal Author(s): Langmacker, Ron; Price, Bruce Requires all sales of aluminum or aluminum alloy be reported, except for the sale of aluminum cans.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1227 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Stanley, Fred Extends benefits of the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance to board members of any rural water, sewer, gas or solid waste management district or nonprofit water corporation.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

SB1231 Principal Author(s): Langmacker, Ron; Price, Bruce Expands conditions of suspended sentences.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Engrossed - Senate
