**HB2430** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Settle, Bill; Relates to Workers' Compensation Act. Provides for offices of the Act in Tulsa and specifies judges to be situated in Tulsa. Modifies exemptions from the Workers' Compensation Act. Requires mediation prior to filing certain claims. Modifies injuries not subject to workers' compensation. Modifies physician choice under workplace medical claims. Requires report from Insurance Commissioner to inform Legislature on the status of 24-hour care pilot program. Modifies number of physicians and report information. **HB2438** Principal Author(s): Eddins, Joe; Littlefield, Rick; Relates to public health and safety; modifies the definition of 'administrator'; states that distance between ICF-MR/16 facilities shall not exceed twenty (20) miles; directs said administrator to follow rules promulgated by the Oklahoma State Department of Health.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 03/07/96, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute.

**HB2448** Principal Author(s): Maddux, Elmer L.; Price, Bruce; Relates to the disposal of lands under the jurisdiction of the Commissioners of the Land Office. Stipulates that appraisers must be appointed by the Commissioners of the Land Office.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. **HB2466** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed; Amends language relating to a teacher's right to due process and compensation or benefits when a board of education receives a superintendent's recommendation for a teacher's dismissal unless the career teacher is convicted of a felony.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. **HB2471** Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Herbert, Dave; Requires only state agencies, (excludes boards and commissions) to furnish copies of financial audits, compliance audits, and program reviews to the Office of State Finance, the State Auditor and Inspector and the Legislative Services Bureau. Deletes language regarding the Legislative Service Bureau providing copies to legislative leadership.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 03/04/96, Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Appropriations (S).

**HB2473** Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Fisher, Ted V.; Amends language relating to the assessment and valuation of property. States if property is not leased within the year prior to January 1 of the initial assessment year, the county assessor will assess the improvements based on the fair market value of the property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 03/04/96, Senate Introduction And First Reading, 03/05/96, Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Finance (S).
