- Floor substitute for HB1162, authored by Rep. Dwayne Steidley, D-Claremore, passed with a vote of 87 to 13. The measure was reconsidered by members.
- HB2080, authored by Rep. Jack Begley, D-Goodwell, passed with a vote of 100-0, with the title stricken and an emergency clause.
- HB2089, authored by Rep. Larry Roberts, D-Miami, passed with a vote of 98-0 with the title stricken.
- HB2133, authored by Rep. Dan Ramsey, R-Chickasaw, passed with a vote of 92 to 2. Title stricken.
- HB2205 (committee substitute), authored by Rep. Bill Settle, D-Muskogee, passed with a vote of 99-0.
- HB2206 (committee substitute), authored by Settle, passed with a vote of 100-0 as amended.
- HB2291, authored by Rep. Larry Adair, D-Stilwell, passed with a vote of 99 to 1. Title stricken.
- HB2292, also authored by Adair, passed unanimously with an emergency clause. The measure was amended to allow public entities to access the records of the Department of Wildlife Conservation.
- HB2317 (floor substitute), by James Hager, D-Pawhuska, passed with a vote of 86-14, with the title stricken, as amended with an emergency clause.
- HB2334, authored by Rep. Betty Boyd, D-Tulsa, passed with a vote of 101-0.
- HB2335, authored by Boyd, passed with a vote of 100-0, with an emergency clause.
- HB2358 (committee substitute), authored by Rep. Robert Weaver, D-Shawnee, passed with a vote of 99-0.
- HB2362 (committee substitute), authored by Rep. Fred Morgan, R-Oklahoma City, passed with a vote of 100-0.
- HB2409, authored by Rep. Scott Adkins, R-Broken Arrow, passed with a vote of 98 to 2.
- HB2463 (committee substitute), authored by Rep. James Dunegan, D-Calera, passed with a vote of 100-0 with the title stricken and an emergency clause.
- HB2470 (committee substitute), authored by Rep. Abe Deutschendorf, D-Lawton, passed with a vote of 99-1 with an emergency clause.
- HB2530, authored by Rep. James Hamilton, D-Poteau, passed with a vote of 99-0 with an emergency clause.
- HB2559, authored by Rep. Weaver, passed with a vote of 101-0 with an emergency clause.
- HB2563, authored by Rep. James Hager, D-Pawhuska, passed with a vote of 100-0.
- HB2601, authored by Rep. William Paulk, D-Oklahoma City, passed with a vote of 85-14, as amended.
- HB2613, authored by Rep. William Paulk, D-Oklahoma City, passed with a vote of 100 to 0. The measure was amended to include crossbows.
