HB2133 Principal Author(s): Ramsey, Dan Provides sales tax exemption for public trusts in which a county or municipality is the beneficiary.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Title Stricken, Third Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Engrossed - House

HB2152 Principal Author(s): Satterfield, Shelby; Smith, Jerry L. Adds other areas used for court functions to the acceptable list of expenses court funds may incur.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2156 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Reese, Jim Modifies language relating to parking privileges for physically disabled persons.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Human Resources (S)

HB2161 Principal Author(s): O'Neal, Mike; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Adds contempt charges for children not completing community service as ordered and provides that the court may order the child to serve up to 48 hours in a municipal facility.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2163 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Prohibits retirement credits for military service performed prior to the date the member begins participation in Public Retirement Systems.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2175 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Easley, Kevin A. Provides that the court may order restitution and clean up of trash in lieu of fine and jail sentence for the deliberate dumping of trash and/or littering public property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2193 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Allows school districts to create their own educational improvement plan; deletes required components of said plan; allows districts to request an exemption from any statutory requirement or State Board rule not related to bilingual and special education programs, health and safety provisions, school finance, State Aid, pupil formula weights, teacher salary and teacher retirement, the Oklahoma School Testing Program and the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2205 Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill Clarifies language relevant to the fraudulent appropriation through embezzlement by a person to whom the property has been entrusted.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2214 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Easley, Kevin A. Permits acquiring banks to establish unused branch banking rights. Requires agency relationship of bank holding companies, branches, and affiliates banks to be consistent with banking practices and regulations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2223 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Modifies references in relation to county commissioners; prohibits county commissioners from spending funds for any purpose other than normal operating expenditures.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. HB2239 Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Erwin, Randall L. Modifies language relating to fishing and game licenses.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2254 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Monson, Angela Creates a task force to develop a 24 hour health and disability coverage to function as an alternative to workers' compensation coverage.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2255 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Brown, Ben Creates the Defective Assistive Device Act; defines terms; states that any manufacturer who sells an assistive device shall provide the consumer with an express warranty for the device; provides for repair and or replacement of said vehicle; provides for disputes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2261 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Monson, Angela Requires all individual and group health insurance policies providing coverage to women over the age of thirty-five (35) to include coverage for a routine bone density test; defines terms.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2303 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C. Stipulates that the costs of detaining a child may be recovered by the county commissioners as ordered by the court from a parent, legal guardian, or legal custodian.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

HB2310 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Stipe, Gene Modifies language pertaining to the Plumbing License Law of 1955. Defines the terms 'plumbing contractor' and 'journeyman plumber technician'.
