**HB2502** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Long, Ed Requires hospitals and insurers to reflect any discounted services in billing of services; provides penalty for violation; directs the State Board of Health and the Insurance Commissioner to promulgate related rules.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2507** Principal Author(s): Perry, Fred Requires a municipality to disclose the price paid for land adjoining or contiguous to condemned property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2512** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Transfers authority over the Oklahoma Office of Volunteerism from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; Creates the Oklahoma Commission on Volunteerism; directs the Office of the Secretary of State to provide staff support; states powers and duties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2530** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Long, Ed States that a partial term of not more than eighteen months (18) for a member of the Board of Trustees of a library system shall not be considered a full term.; Emergency. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Third Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Engrossed - House

**HB2553** Principal Author(s): Douglass, Brooks; Seikel, Mark Relates to the Agents Licensing Act; deletes surplus line insurance brokers from licensing requirements; adds fraternal agents to licensing requirements; modifies language and fees; modifies educational requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Business & Labor (S)

**HB2554** Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Vaughn, Ray Requires divorced couples to meet educational requirements on the needs of the child involved; establishes a mandatory course for divorcing parents as a pilot program in Judicial District 22; directs the Supreme Court to promulgate rules for said program; provides for study outline, completion certification, payment and reports to legislative leadership.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2559** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Weaver, Robert E. Provides for investment of funds from prepaid funeral benefit contracts.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Third Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Engrossed - House

**HB2561** Principal Author(s): Thornbrugh, C. Michael Deletes requirement that a lien entry form be prescribed by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; provides for computer generation of said form; provides that the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall retain the right to prescribe contents of said form.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2563** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E. Provides for alternative teaching certification for residential or treatment facilities.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Third Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Engrossed - House

**HB2588** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Long, Ed States that the Oklahoma Historical Society may sponsor and administer state participation in the annual National History Day competition.; Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2601** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Paulk, William R. Clarifies language relating to procedural requirements for the ouster of certain officers.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Floor Amendment, Third Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Engrossed - House

**HB2604** Principal Author(s): Satterfield, Shelby; Wilkerson, Dick Modifies various references including those pertaining to driving across highway dividing spaces; the installation of blue lights on vehicles other than authorized emergency vehicles; and covering or otherwise overlaying vehicle license plates.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2611** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Rozell, Herb Creates the Public and Correctional Facility Finance Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2613** Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R. Modifies the condition by which murder in the first degree occurs.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Advanced From General Order, Motion Adopted - House, Floor Amendment, Third Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Engrossed - House

**HB2615** Principal Author(s): Douglass, Brooks; Paulk, William R. Stipulates that the only issues that may be raised in an application for post conviction relief are those that were not and could not have been raised in a direct appeal or those that support a conclusion that the outcome of the trial would have been different. States that all such applications must be filed within one year from the date the conviction is final, or in the case of an appeal, one year from the date the appellate decision is final. Specifies that the district court may not consider subsequent application unless certain information is provided.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading

**HB2619** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Paulk, William R. Makes the disclosures of grand jury proceedings by a witness a misdemeanor.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Introduction And First Reading
