**SB1000** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1011** Principal Author(s): Thornbrugh, C. Michael; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Removes previous convictions of two or more felonies from the list of eligibility requirements for a community sentencing program.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1012** Principal Author(s): Ferguson, Larry R.; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Provides for the immediate deportation of non U.S. citizens who are received into the custody of the Department of Corrections.; Emergency. Laid Over - Senate, General Order - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1017** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank States that the Troop Commander in charge of a highway patrol troop may designate specified portions of federal aid primary highways and the state highway system in the service area of the troop.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Public Safety (H)

**SB1030** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Price, Bruce Creates the Industry Advisory Committee within the Oklahoma Food and Agricultural Products Research and Technology Center at Oklahoma State University.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Agriculture (H)

**SB1035** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hefner, Jerry W. Provides definition and licensing requirements for 'All-terrain vehicles.'; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1059** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Stipe, Gene Abolishes the Transportation Division of the Corporation Commission and the Motor Vehicle Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Transportation (H)

**SB1070** Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Steidley, Dwayne Authorizes boards of education to enter into contracts for the purpose of implementing energy conservation measures designed to reduce the energy consumption or operating costs of school facilities.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Education (H)

**SB1071** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Education (H)

**SB1077** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale W. Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of Department of Central Services, and boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

**SB1097** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Staggs, Barbara Modifies and defines language pertaining to Group Homes for Persons with Development Disabilities. Creates interdisciplinary team to determine on-site staffing requirements. Provides that copies of procedures for receipts and investigations be distributed to all providers of group home services. Recodifies language in bill.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

**SB1101** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith Deletes fee remittance requirement relating to payment of removal fees to the state for motor vehicles.; Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Public Safety (H)

**SB1106** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; prohibits the Board from offering a health plan which is owned or operated by the state and which utilizes a capitated payment plan for providers which uses a primary care physician as a gatekeeper to any specialty care provided by physician-specialists, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Rules (H)

**SB1115** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies statutory references relating to drivers licenses, motorcycle safety instruction permits, and special motorcycle permits.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Introduction And First Reading

**SB1123** Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies list of prescription and non prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act.; Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

**SB1128** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies sections pertaining to the classification of positions.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1129** Principal Author(s): Dunlap, James R.; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Changes the name of the Executive Branch Reform Act of 1986 to the Cabinet Organization Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Failed - Senate, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

**SB1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. Modifies requirements for eligibility for longevity; requires the development of reduction in force plans; and defines recall procedures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1151** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Requires cost of incarceration to be calculated and credited to the inmate's obligation for cost. Requires DOC to pay to the Crime Victim's Center 15% of any gross wages earned by an inmate in a private prison industries program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**SB1162** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Ford, Charles R.; Steidley, Dwayne; Taylor, Stratton; Williams, Penny Declares the University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College to be a single institution; transfers supervision, management and control of the University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College from the Board of Trustees of University Center at Tulsa and the Board of Regents of Rogers State College to the Board of Regents of University Center at Tulsa and Rogers State College; defines the regents' members; set terms of office for future regents.; Effective Date: 04/01/96 Emergency. Enrolled - Senate
