**HB2252** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Changes the required measurement for motorcycle headlamps from not more than 54 inches nor less than 22 inches.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2255** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Brown, Ben Creates the Defective Assistive Device Act; defines terms; states that any manufacturer who sells an assistive device shall provide the consumer with an express warranty for the device; provides for repair and or replacement of said vehicle; provides for disputes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2277** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave Modifies language relating to the jurisdiction of cities and towns and the governing and regulating within the boundaries of that city or town.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Senate Amendments Pending

**HB2278** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben States minimum requirements for a second or subsequent drug and alcohol substance abuse course for those having had a related revocation or suspension; provides for criteria for offenders under the age of 21.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/25/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2279** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben Exempts persons over the age of sixty-five (65) from paying a fee for a traffic record summary furnished by the Department of Public Safety or a motor license agent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2283** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hutchison, Joe J. Provides for special license plate for the Order of the Eastern Star. Provides qualifications for issuance, fees and design of said license plate. Refers to several special license plates.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/20/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2291** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Lewis Jr. Clarifies language relevant to the suspension, demotion, or termination of education support employees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2292** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Directs Wildlife Conservation to keep confidential certain personal information provided with permit and license applications.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2293** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Provides authority for Wildlife Conservation to enter into contracts and agreements for food, lodging, and other authorized expenses necessary to host, conduct, sponsor or participate in conferences, meetings, or training sessions.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2294** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes Wildlife Conservation to sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material it produces.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2300** Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Leist, M. C. Authorizes the establishment of a forestry cost-share program. Creates the Forestry Cost-Share Fund. Prohibits the use of the fund for state agency purposes. Provides for eligibility criteria for basis of approval or denial of applications. Provides the appointment of an advisory committee.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2309** Principal Author(s): Deutschendorf, Abe; Long, Lewis Jr. Allows school districts to employ teachers or allow teachers under contract to teach a grade level or a curricular area in which the teacher is not licensed on a temporary basis to accommodate increases and decreases in student population for no longer than 1 semester. The teacher will be required to hold a valid certificate or be licensed in the teaching profession. Unli-

censed personnel may monitor interactive video instructional programs or classes taught through distance learning technology.; Emergency; 03/19/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2310** Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Stipe, Gene Modifies language pertaining to the Plumbing License Law of 1955. Defines the terms "plumbing contractor" and "journeyman plumber technician". Allows the State Department of Health to renew licenses.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/25/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2317** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Deletes contextual requirement relating the residence of a child for school purposes; clarifies statutory reference.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/25/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2320** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Herbert, Dave States that compensation of all elective city officers shall be fixed by ordinance.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Senate Amendments Pending

**HB2323** Principal Author(s): Smith, Dale Creates the "School District Budget Act."; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2332** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Williams, Penny Recodifies the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act.; Emergency; 03/25/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2335** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Long, Ed Allows a school board to create a policy regarding the food expenses of employees of the district incurred during travel.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2336** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Kerr, Robert M. Allows for university and college supporting license plates to include those of private universities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Senate Amendments Pending

**HB2338** Principal Author(s): Cotner, Howard; Dickerson, Larry Relates to revenue and taxation; states that no assessment shall be required if a report or return, signed by the taxpayer, was filed and the liability evidenced by the report or return has not been paid.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2346** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Directs the Commissioner of Public Safety to require a gas cap integrity test for motor vehicles.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate
