HB2348 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Provides coverage requirement for health benefit plans as they relate to maternity coverage.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/25/96, General Order - Senate

HB2349 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes the Wildlife Conservation Commission to establish a special use permit required by all persons who hunt or fish on private land leased by the Department of Wildlife Conservation; establishes a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) maximum annual fee for such license.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2351 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Shurden, Frank Modifies language relating to non-resident hunting licenses.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2359 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Increases the amount of accrual not to be considered by the applicant for and recipient of funeral benefits from Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) to Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).; Emergency; 03/27/96, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

Directs the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Tax Commission to conduct a study relating to the regulation and licensing of jet ski and boat operators in the state; requires a report of the findings to be submitted to the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Governor.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2361 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Weaver, Robert E. Allows investments to be made by banking institution trust departments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, General Order - Senate

HB2362 Principal Author(s): Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, General Order - Senate

HB2373 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2393 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Creates the Early Identification and Service Support for Children and Families Act; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth. HB2408 Principal Author(s): Harrison, J. Berry; Widener, Bill Modifies language relating to Rural Water, Sewer, Gas, and Solid Waste Management Districts Act.; Emergency; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2414 Principal Author(s): Kerr, Robert M.; Mitchell, Bill J. Prohibits transportation of over-size farm equipment by trailer on any highway during the hours of darkness.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2435 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Rice, Larry Modifies powers and duties of Urban Renewal Authority relating to condemnation of property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/20/96, General Order - Senate

HB2437 Principal Author(s): Eddins, Joe; Long, Ed Requires that underage students shall participate in developmental assessments to determine if the child is ready for admittance to kindergarten; requires the board of education to develop and adopt a written plan outlining the kindergarten program being offered to the underaged child.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2438 Principal Author(s): Eddins, Joe; Littlefield, Rick Relates to public health and safety; modifies the definition of "administrator"; states that distance between ICF-MR/16 facilities shall not exceed twenty (20) miles; directs said administrator to follow rules promulgated by the Oklahoma State Department of Health.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/07/96, General Order - Senate
