HB2561 Principal Author(s): Thornbrugh, C. Michael; Weedn, Trish Deletes requirement that a lien entry form be prescribed by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; provides for computer generation of said form; provides that the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall retain the right to prescribe contents of said form.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/26/96, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

HB2563 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Provides for alternative teaching certification for residential or treatment facilities.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2574 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Morgan, Fred Provides that rules of the State Board of Health shall not require euthanasia and disposal of domesticated wild animals with rabies or suspected to be infected with rabies without consideration of specific criteria.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Senate Amendments Pending

HB2583 Principal Author(s): Pettigrew, Wayne Prescribes procedures for notification to members of total assets and liabilities and total unfunded actuarial accrued liability of various retirement systems.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/25/96, Report Progress (unofficial), Appropriations (S)

HB2584 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Requires approval by county commissioners of the sale by auction of properties acquired by the county under the provisions of the resale tax laws.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/20/96, General Order - Senate

HB2588 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Long, Ed States that the Oklahoma Historical Society may sponsor and administer state participation in the annual National History Day competition.; Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2603 Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R.; Weedn, Trish Provides that any person who willfully or maliciously sets fire to, causes to be burned, or burns another person shall be guilty of arson in the first degree.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2604 Principal Author(s): Satterfield, Shelby; Wilkerson, Dick Modifies various references including those pertaining to driving across highway dividing spaces; the installation of blue lights on vehicles other than authorized emergency vehicles; and covering or otherwise overlaying vehicle license plates.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2611 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Rozell, Herb Creates the Public and Correctional Facility Finance Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2617 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Paulk, William R. Provides for crimes against witnesses, persons attending official proceedings, and informants.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2620 Principal Author(s): Davis, Frank W.; Maddox, James R. Creates the Construction Division within the Department of Corrections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2621 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. Enacts the State Employees Fair Labor Relations Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2622 Principal Author(s): Davis, Frank W.; Smith, Jerry L. Provides criminal penalty for any person falsely executing a written declaration as a witness or misrepresenting his or her identity with the intent to defraud, relevant to the execution of self-proved wills and codicils.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Senate Amendments Pending

HB2623 Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Hendrick, Howard H. States that a group or combination of persons or risks shall not be considered a "fictitious" group upon meeting the conditions provided within this section.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

HB2637 Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Smith, Bill Relates to game and fish programs and licensing. Extends and renames former programs, outlines hunting license fees, and donation designation requirements.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2642 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Defines the purposes of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department petty cash fund, and regulates exemptions from the Central Purchasing Act and petty cash fund of the Tourism and Recreation Dept.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate

HB2647 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Amends title language relating to The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority providing funds for repairs to Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department properties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/28/96, Engrossed - Senate

HB2648 Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Monson, Angela Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act. Requires an annual report and a certificate of need for home health care agencies. Stipulates conditions and actions prior to issuance of certificate of need. Provides process and conditions for opposition and specifies penalties to be charged with a misdemeanor and fined between \$100 and \$500.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2653 Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Monson, Angela Modifies procedures for determination of disability relating to the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System. Changes the determination by the Social Security Administration and the Department of Health and Human Services to the Medical Director of Oklahoma State and Education Employees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/25/96, Report Progress (unofficial)

HB2666 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Ross, Don States the dues and fees to YMCA's or YWCA's for the use of facilities or services for persons under age 16 are exempt from sales tax.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

HB2667 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Stanley, Fred Reapportions the fees, taxes and penalties received from the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act to the General Revenue Fund and State Transportation Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2668 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Requires voter registration transfer notification within certain time constraints, enforces certain restrictions applying for residency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/20/96, General Order - Senate

HB2669 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Roberts, Darryl F. Authorizes National Park Service rangers to make arrests with the same status as state or local law enforcement if it is believed the offender has committed a felony, misdemeanor or at the request of a law enforcement officer.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate
