HB2671 Principal Author(s): Johnson, Glen D.; Taylor, Stratton Enacts the "State Employee Pay Evaluation Act of 1996"; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2690 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Creates the Oklahoma Privatization Functions Act.; Effective Date: 12/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

HB2692 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Fisher, Ted V. Places the Juvenile Justice Advisory and Oversight Committee under the supervision of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; states that the amount of a juvenile's earnings designated for restitution to victims shall be placed in the Juvenile Restitution Revolving Fund; states that acquisitions or purchases of clothing for juveniles or acquisitions of food for group homes under the custody of the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; expands provisional scope to include purchases from such funds received by offices administrated by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/13/96, General Order - Senate

HB2698 Principal Author(s): Ervin, Mike; Henry, Brad Allows the Department of Human Services to charge a service fee to those obliged to pay child support to cover administrative costs; states that such fees shall be deposited into the Child Support Revenue Enhancement Fund.; Emergency; 03/25/96, General Order - Senate

HB2701 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Satterfield, Shelby Modifies acceptable bell types for locomotives to include air horns.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Senate Amendments Pending

HB2704 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Municipal Code.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/26/96, General Order - Senate
