**HB2940** Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne; Williams, Penny Modifies selection process for nomination of Presidential Electors and residency requirements. Provides for designation on ballots and casting of votes for the Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates.; Effective Date: 07/01/97; 03/28/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2946** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies statutory reference relating to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, Enrolled - House

**HB2950** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Fields, Lloyd Modifies language pertaining to private prison facilities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2953** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Seikel, Mark Clarifies legislative intent regarding reporting obligations within the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act.; Emergency; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2959** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Provides tax credit against taxes imposed for direct investments by agricultural cooperative marketing associations in agricultural joint ventures created and designed to develop and advance the production, processing, handling and marketing of agricultural commodities grown, made or manufactured in Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2960** Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Weedn, Trish Directs DHS to cooperate with and help promote foster parent associations in each county; provide additional services relating to the placement of children in foster care; develop a policy of accident, personal liability, and automobile liability insurance; and develop a procedure to determine the ability of parents to pay part or all of the costs for foster care.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2962** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Fisher, Ted V. Clarifies language within the Oklahoma Children's Code to address compulsory school attendance.; Emergency; 03/13/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2964** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of

Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes.; Emergency; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2969** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2971** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Clarifies language pertaining to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Distinguishes adopted children from biological children with regard to beneficiaries. Defines beneficiary.; Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2972** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Creates the Oklahoma Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment Act, which encourages voluntary remediation of contaminated sites by limiting the liability of property owners; fosters reuse of property previously contaminated and establishes a voluntary site remediation program to assist property owners.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2975** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2981** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave Provides for the establishment of the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners, the election of the members, and the duties of the position.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/14/96, Senate Amendments Pending

**HB2982** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Thomas, Tommy Provides for membership of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board; transfers authority of said board to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority after July 1, 1996.; Emergency; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2986** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Long, Ed Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/28/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB2988** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Authorizes the State Board of Agriculture to establish fees; provides for other surety

allowable for livestock markets by the US Packers and Stockyards Act; and provides penalties upon the suspension, revocation, or expiration of livestock auction market licenses. Defines livestock and exotic animals.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2989** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Creates the Livestock Dealers Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB2990** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Creates the "Oklahoma Centralized Support Registry Act" to regulate the payment of all child support, spousal support and other related payments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB3000** Principal Author(s): Gray, Charles; Rubottom, Don Declares "Oklahoma My Native Land" the official children's song of the state.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB3006** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies required deadlines for authorization to establish branch banks.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - Senate

**HB3008** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Directs the Department of Corrections to not house or process inmates at the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in Oklahoma City. States that no inmate shall be allowed to enter or remain in the building or on the grounds of the building, unless the inmate is under the direct supervision of DOC personnel.; Emergency; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB3021** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Brown, Ben Requires individual and group insurance policies to provide coverage for equipment, services and supplies for treatment of diabetes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, Do Pass (unofficial)

**HB3026** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike Provides a deduction from the taxable income of any resident taxpayer who is a swine or poultry producer who constructs or expands a swine or poultry production facility in this state.; Effective Date: 01/01/97; 03/26/96, Do Pass Failed (unofficial)

**HB3028** Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Wilkerson, Dick States that any written bill of sale, timber deed or timber contract shall be preserved by the owner or operator of a logging or timber harvesting operation for at least a period of three (3) years. Within said time frame, law enforcement personnel may inspect records.; Emergency; 03/27/96, Signed & Transmitted To Governor
