SB 16 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Weedn, Trish Authorizes the Department of Wildlife Conservation, the Oklahoma State Department of Health, Department of Human Services, Department of Transportation, Oklahoma Water Resources Board, Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Environmental Health and Substance Abuse Services to enter into contracts and agreements for the payment of food and lodging expenses; allows such expenses to be paid directly to contracting agency or business establishment.; Effective Date: 11/01/95; 05/17/95, Second CCR Read - Senate

SB 49 Principal Author(s): Gray, Charles; Roberts, Darryl F. Relates to the Administrative Procedures Act; clarifies statutory reference.; Emergency; 05/08/95, CCR Read By Senate

SB 73 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Vaughn, Ray Creates the Oklahoma Child Visitation Registry Act; authorizes district judge in each county in the State to authorize one or more public or private agencies to provide a child visitation registry program and allows participating agency to charge a fee not to exceed five dollars per parent, per visit.; Effective Date: 01/01/97; 03/20/96, General Order - House

SB 74 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Relates to runaway children; adds runaway child to crime of contributing to delinquency; defines runaway child; criminalizes harbouring certain runaway children; provides penalty.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/21/96, General Order - House

SB 182 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Modifies budgetary limits of the Department of Veterans; Eng. Hs. Amend. strikes enacting clause.; Emergency; 05/24/95, CCR Read By Senate

SB 186 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Creates the Rural Oklahoma Assistance and Development System (ROADS) Act; expresses legislative intent to appropriate to the Department of Transportation funds for construction and maintenance on rural roads in addition to other appropriations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

SB 330 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Authorizes certain state employees to use rental cars in lieu of commuter airplanes.; Emergency; 05/10/95, CCR Read By House

SB 351 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Roberts, Darryl F. Creates the Oklahoma Telecommunications Authority to coordinate all state telecommunications projects that involve data and video transmission services.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency; 05/16/95, Conferees Disagree
