SB 747 Principal Author(s): Maddux, Elmer L.; Snyder, Mark Modifies vote required of beneficiary which is a county in order to waive certain competitive bidding requirement to two thirds of the governing body.; Effective Date: 07/01/96; 03/28/96, General Order - House
