Requires the State Board of Education to establish for the 96-97 school year a pilot project designed to ensure that all students entering the third grade are reading at the appropriate reading skill level. SB 981 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Deletes weight limit provisions pertaining to vehicles delivering agricultural commodi-

ties weighed as a single draft.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/21/96, General Order - House

SB 982 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Price, Bruce Directs the Department of Agriculture and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to establish a strategic plan relating to value-added agricultural products.; Emergency; 03/19/96, General Order - House

Requires the department to publish all engineering estimates at least 10 days prior to the bid submission closing date.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/21/96, General Order - House

SB 988 Principal Author(s): Dunegan, James H.; Stipe, Gene Requires Dept. of Transportation to issue permits for multi-state oversize and overweight vehicles. Designates specific routes for vehicles operating under such permits.; Emergency; 03/28/96, General Order - House

SB 989 Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private monies to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements.; Emergency; 03/21/96, Laid Over (unofficial), Transportation (H)

SB 993 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/18/96, General Order - House
