### Senate Measures Continued

**SB 1071** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - House

**SB 1077** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale W. Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of Department of Central Services, and boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1080** Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Snyder, Mark Requires that a complete disclosure of name, mailing address and finding address of every stockholder with at least five percent ownership shall be included with each hospice license application.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/19/96, General Order - House

**SB 1082** Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Grants authority for certain part time employment within specified cities and towns by off duty police officers.; Emergency; 03/28/96, House Amendments Read

**SB 1087** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Makes \$40.00 per month fee for persons with a deferred prosecution program supervised by the Probation and Parole Division of the Department of Corrections.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1097** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Staggs, Barbara Modifies and defines language pertaining to Group Homes for Persons with Development Disabilities. Creates interdisciplinary team to determine on-site staffing requirements. Provides that copies of procedures for receipts and investigations be distributed to all providers of group home services. Recodifies language in bill.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1100** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don Directs property taxes of railroads and public service corporations shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and states that all others shall be paid to the appropriate county treasurer; states that such taxes paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be deposited into Protected Ad Valorem Tax Revolving Fund; removes due date for payment; replaces references to Head Start programs with language relating to free or reduced lunches as it relates to admission into early

childhood programs; deletes specified contents of report to the governor; deletes probationary accreditation requirements; modifies authority of the State Department of Education; provides for emergency school transfers; modifies midterm funding; provides for pupil removal from class; creates the Oklahoma Accountability System; creates the Technology Endowment Fund; authorizes the State Board of Education to award Statewide Alternative Education Program Grants; directs the board to promulgate rules establishing the Oklahoma Advanced Placement Incentive Program; provides funding for teacher bonus programs; repeals sections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1101** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Deletes fee remittance requirement relating to payment of removal fees to the state for motor vehicles.; Emergency; 03/18/96, General Order - House

**SB 1106** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; prohibits the Board from offering a health plan which is owned or operated by the state and which utilizes a capitated payment plan for providers which uses a primary care physician as a gatekeeper to any specialty care provided by physician-specialists, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - House

**SB 1111** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000,000. The amount of the exemption allowed is pursuant to the provisions of Section 809 of this title.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1115** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies statutory references relating to drivers licenses, motorcycle safety instruction permits, and special motorcycle permits.;

**SB 1122** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben Authorizes municipalities to prosecute minors for violating firearms ordinances.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/21/96, General Order - House

**SB 1123** Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies list of prescription and non prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1125** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Modifies commission districts within the Transportation Commission.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/25/96, General Order - House

**SB 1128** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies salaries of court reporters and county election board secretaries.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/28/96, Engrossed - House

**SB 1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1133** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Monson, Angela Exempts sales of tangible personal property or services to certain organizations from sales taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 03/26/96, General Order - House

**SB 1135** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Clarifies references pertaining to food stamp fraud.; Emergency; 03/27/96, General Order - House

**SB 1147** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Shedrick, Bernice Prohibits the use of accident reports for commercial purposes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 03/28/96, Engrossed - House

**SB 1150** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Lengthens amount of time needed before the arrested is brought before a court from 24 to 48 hours. Modifies procedures for an arresting peace officer and the subsequent actions that must be undertaken.; Emergency; 03/20/96, General Order - House
