HB1215 Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J. Designates the stretch of roadway from the intersection of State Highways 20 and 82 (Spavinaw "Y") south to Spavinaw Creek as the "Mickey Mantle Memorial Highway."; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB1621 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Williams, Penny Modifies language relating to the Ad Valorem Tax Code; provides an exemption for households earning less than \$12,000.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB1672 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Toure, Opio Modifies definitions of terms in the Employment Security Act of 1980; provides conditions under which an employee cannot be disqualified for benefits.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - Senate

HB1860 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Littlefield, Rick Relates to motor vehicles; doubles fines for speeding in construction zones.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB1989 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies duties of the district court judge in issuing certain instructions relating to acquisition of lands by purchase, donation or condemnation.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB2053 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2054 Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Recognizes English to be the official language of the State of Oklahoma; requires official public documents and records to be printed in English; states the law shall not apply to foreign language

courses, instruction to students with limited English proficiency during transition into the general education system, when it is deemed to interfere with needs of the justice system, or when public safety, health or emergency services require the use of a foreign language.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second Reading - Referred To Senate Committee, Rules (S)

HB2056 Principal Author(s): Douglass, Brooks; Pettigrew, Wayne Requires the Department of Corrections to provide a place within the walls of the state prison at McAlester so that members of the immediate family of any deceased victim of the defendant may witness the execution; requires the judge who presided at the trial and the chief of police of the municipality in which the crime occurred to witness the execution.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2087 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies references to the Oklahoma State Pension Commission.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2091 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - Senate

HB2101 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Ferguson, Larry R. Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of education of a municipality with a population of over 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of more than 2,500

to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2102 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Provides for loss of business and economic incentives for railroads and public service corporations upon protest of ad valorem taxes; provides for proration of lost incentives.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB2112 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Modifies penalty for defacing, stealing or possessing road signs or markers and provides effective date.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

HB2121 Principal Author(s): Wells, Dale W. Changes fee and effective date of special fuel use tax.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2122 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Henry, Brad Provides certain requirements of attorneys, modifying procedures related to issuance of subpoena's; discovery procedures with respect to expert witnesses; and motions for protective orders. Authorizes methods for taking depositions and provisions related to examinations of witnesses; imposing requirement related to objections to evidence. Provides safekeeping of depositions and requiring copies be recorded in a certain manner, modifying reference; providing for presentation of depositions during evidentiary proceeding and with respect to interrogations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.
