Berry; Taylor, Gary Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996, to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council, Special Agency Account Board, Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters, EMS Advisory Council, Committee for Day Treatment Standards, Basic Health Benefits Board, Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA.; Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2146 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; McCorkell, Don Jr. Creates the Economic Development Reform Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB2152 Principal Author(s): Satterfield, Shelby; Smith, Jerry L. Adds other areas used for court functions to the acceptable list of expenses court funds may incur.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

HB2163 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Prohibits retirement credits for military service performed prior to the date the member begins participation in Public Retirement Systems.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - Senate

HB2182 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2192 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Youth Apprenticeship Committee.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2213 Principal Author(s): Cotner, Howard; Kerr, Robert M. Modifies description of geographic areas represented by the Red River Boundary Commission.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2214 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Easley, Kevin A. Permits acquiring banks to establish unused branch banking rights. Requires agency relationship of bank holding companies,

branches, and affiliates banks to be consistent with banking practices and regulations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2223 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Modifies references in relation to county commissioners; prohibits county commissioners from spending funds for any purpose other than normal operating expenditures.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

HB2227 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick Provides that a judge may issue a search warrant for an occupied dwelling if he finds evidence that the evidence is located on the premises between 10:00pm and 6:00am, the search is a crime scene search, or the subject of the warrant is a fugitive or the subject of an outstanding warrant; states that search warrants for other than occupied dwellings may be served at any time without special direction.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2232 Principal Author(s): Weedn, Trish; Widener, Bill Requires that within twenty (20) days after the proposed charter from the board of freeholders, a municipal governing body shall publish the proposed charter and an announcement of the date of the charter election in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality once per week for three consecutive weeks.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2252 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Changes the required measurement for motorcycle headlamps from not more than 54 inches nor less than 22 inches.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2255 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Brown, Ben Creates the Defective Assistive Device Act; defines terms; states that any manufacturer who sells an assistive device shall provide the consumer with an express warranty for the device; provides for repair and or replacement of said vehicle; provides for disputes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2268 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Creates the "Charter Schools

Pilot Program Act."; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2291 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Lewis Jr. Clarifies language relevant to the suspension, demotion, or termination of education support employees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2336 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Kerr, Robert M. Allows for university and college supporting license plates to include those of private universities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

HB2338 Principal Author(s): Cotner, Howard; Dickerson, Larry Relates to revenue and taxation; states that no assessment shall be required if a report or return, signed by the taxpayer, was filed and the liability evidenced by the report or return has not been paid.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2346 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Directs the Commissioner of Public Safety to require a gas cap integrity test for motor vehicles.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2360 Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E. Directs the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Tax Commission to conduct a study relating to the regulation and licensing of jet ski and boat operators in the state; requires a report of the findings to be submitted to the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Governor.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2361 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Weaver, Robert E. Allows investments to be made by banking institution trust departments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2362 Principal Author(s): Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2373 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.;
