**HB3028** Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Wilkerson, Dick States that any written bill of sale, timber deed or timber contract shall be preserved by the owner or operator of a logging or timber harvesting operation for at least a period of three (3) years. Within said time frame, law enforcement personnel may inspect records.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - Senate

**HB3037** Principal Author(s): Perry, Fred Requires environmental agencies to promulgate rules to establish penalties to be imposed against any person who knowingly makes a false complaint or who knowingly misrepresents or omits material information relating to the complaint.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.
