### Senate Measures Continued

**SB 999** Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Widener, Bill Authorizes for cities, towns and counties to jointly create a hospital authority; allows said authority to levy a two percent (2%) tax on the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales or services in the cities, towns or counties that comprise the authority.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

**SB 1000** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1024** Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Price, Bruce Provides for Oklahoma Department of Commerce support of international trade relationships.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1031** Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Widener, Bill Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

**SB 1040** Principal Author(s): Dunlap, James R.; Hendrick, Howard H. Establishes criteria for setting premiums within the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - House

**SB 1050** Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Stanley, Fred Modifies language relating to fire-arms.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

**SB 1061** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1062** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for the establishment of a crimes information unit within the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1070** Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Steidley, Dwayne Authorizes boards of education

to enter into contracts for the purpose of implementing energy conservation measures designed to reduce the energy consumption or operating costs of school facilities.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - House

**SB 1071** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

**SB 1097** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Staggs, Barbara Modifies and defines language pertaining to Group Homes for Persons with Development Disabilities. Creates interdisciplinary team to determine on-site staffing requirements. Provides that copies of procedures for receipts and investigations be distributed to all providers of group home services. Recodifies language in bill.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1100** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don Directs property taxes of railroads and public service corporations shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and states that all others shall be paid to the appropriate county treasurer; states that such taxes paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be deposited into Protected Ad Valorem Tax Revolving Fund; removes due date for payment; replaces references to Head Start programs with language relating to free or reduced lunches as it relates to admission into early childhood programs; deletes specified contents of report to the governor; deletes probationary accreditation requirements; modifies authority of the State Department of Education; provides for emergency school transfers; modifies midterm funding; provides for pupil removal from class; creates the Oklahoma Accountability System; creates the Technology Endowment Fund; authorizes the State Board of Education to award Statewide Alternative Education Program Grants; directs the board to promulgate rules establishing the Oklahoma Advanced Placement Incentive Program; provides funding for teacher bonus programs; repeals sections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1106** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; prohibits the Board from offering a health plan which is owned or op-

erated by the state and which utilizes a capitated payment plan for providers which uses a primary care physician as a gatekeeper to any specialty care provided by physician-specialists, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

**SB 1111** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000.000. The amount of the exemption allowed is pursuant to the provisions of Section 809 of this title.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1123** Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies list of prescription and non prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1128** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies salaries of court reporters and county election board secretaries.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute

**SB 1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass

**SB 1133** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Monson, Angela Exempts sales of tangible personal property or services to certain organizations from sales taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

**SB 1135** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Clarifies references pertaining to food
