**HB1818** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Makes appropriations to the Department of Transportation and authorizes certain expenditures for urban mass transit, railroad planning and waterways; authorizes expenditures by the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency. Senate Amendments - Rejected, Conference Requested

**HB1819** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Limits the salary of the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and provides duties and compensation of employees.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency. Senate Amendments - Rejected, Conference Requested

**HB1860** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Littlefield, Rick Relates to motor vehicles; doubles fines for speeding in construction zones.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

**HB1989** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies duties of the district court judge in issuing certain instructions relating to acquisition of lands by purchase, donation or condemnation.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - Senate

**HB2053** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

**HB2055** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the mid-term funding formula for schools.; Emergency. Senate Com-

mittee - Do Pass, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

**HB2056** Principal Author(s): Douglass, Brooks; Pettigrew, Wayne Requires the Department of Corrections to provide a place within the walls of the state prison at McAlester so that members of the immediate family of any deceased victim of the defendant may witness the execution; requires the judge who presided at the trial and the chief of police of the municipality in which the crime occurred to witness the execution.; Emergency. **HB2059** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Long, Ed Creates the Oklahoma Tuition Savings Account Act; provides aid and assistance in financing for postsecondary education; defines terms; allows residents to contribute to a tuition savings account not to exceed \$5,000; allows for adjustments in the Oklahoma taxable income and the Oklahoma adjusted gross income; provides for tax exemptions for contributions made after December 31, 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

**HB2072** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E. Modifies language as it relates to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

**HB2080** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack Clarifies language as it relates to the State Aid formula.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

**HB2085** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene Changes the limitation to commence prosecution of certain financial crimes to five (5) years; changes the limitation to commence prosecution for lewd or indecent proposals against children to seven (7) years.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Returned To House, Senate Amendments - Read, Senate Amendments - Pending

**HB2086** Principal Author(s): Dunlap, James R.; Hendrick, Howard H. Deletes population requirements for cities and towns as they relate to the adoption of written investment policies.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

**HB2088** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies language relating to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Plan; states that any person wishing to continue with their life insurance policy after retirement shall pay the full cost of such life insurance at the rate established by the board.; Effective Date: 07/01/

**HB2094** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies references to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

**HB2102** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Provides for loss of business and economic incentives for railroads and public service corporations upon protest of ad valorem taxes; provides for proration of lost incentives.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - Senate

**HB2112** Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Modifies penalty for defacing, stealing or possessing road signs or markers and provides effective date.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Returned To House, Senate Amendments - Read, Senate Amendments - Pending

**HB2115** Principal Author(s): Breckinridge, Flint; Smith, Jerry L. Modifies condition by which murder in the first degree occurs in certain circumstances.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

**HB2120** Principal Author(s): Wells, Dale W.; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Changes the name of military security guards to police officers.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2121** Principal Author(s): Wells, Dale W. Changes fee and effective date of special fuel use tax.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

**HB2122** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Henry, Brad Provides certain requirements of attorneys, modifying procedures related to issuance of subpoena's; discovery procedures with respect to expert witnesses; and motions for protective orders. Authorizes methods for taking depositions and provisions related to examinations of witnesses; imposing requirement related to objections to evidence. Provides safekeeping of depositions and requiring copies be recorded in a certain manner,
