HB2188 Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan; Hendrick, Howard H. Modifies the definition of "medical savings account" to include that which is offered by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; allows any funds remaining in a medical savings account at the end of a tax year to remain in the account for future medical expenses; provides for payment of account funds to the account holder in the event the employee is no longer employed; also provides for an option to retain the account after employment; also allows for transfer of account to a new employer without penalty; requires the board to offer a high deductible health benefit plan; provides employees participating in a deferred compensation plan the option of transferring those funds to a medical sav-

HB2193 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Allows school districts to create their own educational improvement plan; deletes required components of said plan; allows districts to request an exemption from any statutory requirement or State Board rule not related to bilingual and special education programs, health and safety provisions, school finance, State Aid, pupil formula weights, teacher salary and teacher retirement, the Oklahoma School Testing Program and the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.
