HB2255 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Brown, Ben Creates the Defective Assistive Device Act; defines terms; states that any manufacturer who sells an assistive device shall provide the consumer with an express warranty for the device; provides for repair and or replacement of said vehicle; provides for disputes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2271 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2294 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes Wildlife Conservation to sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material it produces.;

HB2300 Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Leist, M. C. Authorizes the establishment of a forestry cost-share program. Creates the Forestry Cost-Share Fund. Prohibits the use of the fund for state agency purposes. Provides for eligibility criteria for basis of approval or denial of applications. Provides the appointment of an advisory committee.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2335 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Long, Ed Allows a school board to create a policy regarding the food expenses of employees of the district incurred during travel.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2336 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Kerr, Robert M. Allows for university and college supporting license plates to include those of private universities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Returned To House, Senate Amendments - Read, Senate Amendments - Pending

HB2338 Principal Author(s): Cotner, Howard; Dickerson, Larry Relates to revenue and taxation; states that no assessment shall be required if a report or return, signed by the taxpayer, was filed and the liability evidenced by the report or return has not been paid.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2346 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Directs the Commissioner of Public Safety to require a gas cap integrity test for motor vehicles.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2349 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L. Authorizes the Wildlife Conservation Commission to establish a special use permit required by all persons who hunt or fish on private land leased by the Department of Wildlife Conservation; establishes a Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) maximum annual fee for such license.; Effective Date: 07/
