HB2950 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Fields, Lloyd Modifies language pertaining to private prison facilities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass

HB2959 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Provides tax credit against taxes imposed for direct investments by agricultural cooperative marketing associations in agricultural joint ventures created and designed to develop and advance the production, processing, handling and marketing of agricultural commodities grown, made or manufactured in Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - Senate

HB2969 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB2971 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Clarifies language pertaining to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Distinguishes adopted children from biological children with regard to beneficiaries. Defines beneficiary.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB2975 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB2988 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Authorizes the State Board of Agriculture to establish fees; provides for other surety allowable for livestock markets by the US Packers and Stockyards Act; and provides penalties upon the suspension, revocation, or expiration of livestock auction market licenses. Defines livestock and exotic animals.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - Senate

HB2989 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Creates the Livestock Dealers Act;

HB2990 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Creates the "Oklahoma Centralized Support Registry Act" to regulate the payment of all child support, spousal support and other related payments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB3006 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies required deadlines for authorization to establish branch banks.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HB3008 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Directs the Department of Corrections to not house or process inmates at the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in Oklahoma City. States that no inmate shall be allowed to enter or remain in the building or on the grounds of the building, unless the inmate is under the direct supervision of DOC personnel.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB3021 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Brown, Ben Requires individual and group insurance policies to provide coverage for equipment, services and supplies for treatment of diabetes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HB3037 Principal Author(s): Perry, Fred Requires environmental agencies to promulgate rules to establish penalties to be imposed against any person who knowingly makes a false complaint or who knowingly misrepresents or omits material information relating to the complaint.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HCR1087 Principal Author(s): Smith, Bill; Stipe, Gene Directs the Department of Corrections to solicit competitive proposals from private prison contractors for the use of up to four 500-cell medium security prisons; setting criteria for proposals and directing distribution.; Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Corrections (H)

HJR1074 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Hamilton, James E. Designates Dec. 7 of each year as "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day."; Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HJR1084 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Steidley, Dwayne Calls for a vote of the people to consider clarification of language per-

taining to the Pardon and Parole Board.; Senate Committee - Do Pass As Amended, Senate Committee - Committee Substitute

HJR1087 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Creates the State Government Internal Affairs Investigation Review Committee.; Emergency. Senate Committee - Do Pass, General Order - Senate

HJR1098 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E. Relates to an emergency rule of the Wildlife Commission; disapproving rule and directing distribution; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 186 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Creates the Rural Oklahoma Assistance and Development System (ROADS) Act; expresses legislative intent to appropriate to the Department of Transportation funds for construction and maintenance on rural roads in addition to other appropriations.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 587 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Monson, Angela Includes advanced practice nurses in list of medical practitioners included in definition of prescription; includes advanced practice nurses in definition of licensed practitioner; specifies that advanced registered nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse-midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetist, and advanced practice nurses such nurses may not dispense drugs but may dispense professional samples; allows such nurses to diagnose, prescribe, distribute, and administer medicines, devices, or treatments as defined by the Board of Nursing; requires such nurses practitioners to accept responsibility to practice in accepted manner for their profession.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 681 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Williams, Penny Modifies the amount of annual household income required for homestead exemptions from \$10,000 to \$15,000; clarifies gender references.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. House Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - House

SB 692 Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Weedn, Trish Changes the name of the Governor's Committee on Employment of the Handicapped to the Governor's Advisory Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass
