SB 905 Principal Author(s): Littlefield, Rick; Roberts, Larry D. Extends benefits of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System to spouses married continuously for the 36 months immediately preceding the member's death.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Consideration And Report

SB 911 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Defines "economically at-risk wells" to include any oil or natural gas producing property which produces 3 barrels or less of oil or 30,000 cubic feet of gas per day unless the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma oil exceeds \$20 calculated on an annual calendar year basis or the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma gas exceeds \$2.50 per Million British Thermal Units calculated on an annual calendar year basis.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 921 Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E.; Wilkerson, Dick Repeals various sections pertaining to sales and income taxes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - House

SB 929 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Littlefield, Rick Authorizes pilot entrance fee program at Dripping Springs State Park in Delaware County.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 941 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Clarifies language pertaining to the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 946 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Hamilton, James E. Updates statutory references pertaining to the Oklahoma Mining Commission; clarifying positions of mining commission member appointments, stating terms of appointments; ratifying certain appointments.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 962 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene Provides for withdrawal of membership of any participating employer delinquent more than 90 days in paying the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System the contributions due.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 974 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Leist, M. C. Requires transporters of waste, wastewater, or sludge to develop and maintain manifests.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 977 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; Tyler, Michael Requires DHS to take into consideration rate increases necessary for the adequate treatment of developmentally disabled clients when setting reimbursement rates.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1000 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1024 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Price, Bruce Provides for Oklahoma Department of Commerce support of international trade relationships.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass As Amended, General Order - House

SB 1028 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. States that contracts pursuant to bids let by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for the construction, repair and maintenance of structures owned by the department shall not be subject to the Oklahoma Purchasing Act; states that all contracts over \$25,000 shall be approved by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; removes contracts entered into for specified purposes by the State Department of Education from exclusion; mandates that the Oklahoma Film Office be located in Tulsa.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 1032 Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Littlefield, Rick Allows any eligible employer of a municipality which is a participating employer in the Oklahoma Public Employees Pension and Retirement System on July 1, 1996 to become a participating municipality of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System on Sept. 1 1996, only if certified copy of a resolution approved by the governing body of the eligible employer or by any other body or officer authorized by law or recognized by the State Board to approve such a resolution and assure that it is filed with the State Board by August 15, 1996. Such election shall be irrevocable. States additional eligibility requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass

SB 1036 Principal Author(s): Johnson, Glen D.; Taylor, Stratton Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Court of Appeals; changes the name of the Court of Appeals to the Court of Civil Appeals.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1061 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the

defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1062 Principal Author(s): Rice, Larry; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for the establishment of a crimes information unit within the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

SB 1077 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale W. Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of Department of Central Services, and boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, House Committee - Committee Substitute, General Order - House

SB 1082 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Grants authority for certain part time employment within specified cities and towns by off duty police officers.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Adopted - Senate, Third Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Engrossed - Senate

SB 1087 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Makes \$40.00 per month fee for persons with a deferred prosecution program supervised by the Probation and Parole Division of the Department of Corrections.; Emergency. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1097 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Staggs, Barbara Modifies and defines language pertaining to Group Homes for Persons with Development Disabilities. Creates interdisciplinary team to determine on-site staffing requirements. Provides that copies of procedures for receipts and investigations be distributed to all providers of group home services. Recodifies language in bill.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. House Committee - Do Pass, General Order - House

SB 1100 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don Directs property taxes of railroads and public service corporations shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and states that all others shall be paid to the appropriate county treasurer; states that such taxes paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be deposited into Protested Ad Valorem Tax Revolving Fund; removes due date for payment; replaces references to Head Start programs with language relating to free or reduced lunches as it relates to admission into early childhood programs; deletes specified contents of report to the governor; deletes probationary accreditation requirements; modifies authority of the State Department of Education; provides for emergency school transfers; modifies midterm funding;
