**SB808** Principal Author(s): Haney, Enoch Kelly, Hamilton, James E.; Appropriates funds to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries and the Secretary of State. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB859** Principal Author(s): Williams, Don; Pope, Clay; Includes weather modification in a list of designated purposes for county sales tax. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB981** Principal Author(s): Kerr, Robert M.; Beutler, Randy; Deletes weight limit provisions pertaining to vehicles delivering agricultural commodities weighed as a single draft. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB983** Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Langmacher, Ron; Sets standards for signs in business areas; authorizes rotating sign faces and setting length and frequency of rotation. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB1080** Principal Author(s): Snyder, Mark; Seikel, Mark; Requires that a complete disclosure of name, mailing address and finding address of every stockholder with at least five percent ownership shall be included with each hospice license application. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/21/96)**

**SB1106** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D.; Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB1147** Principal Author(s): Shedrick, Bernice; Benson, Loyd; Prohibits the use of accident reports for commercial use. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/21/96)**

**SB1175** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Blackburn, Debbie; Excludes collection of child support from statute of limitations. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

**SB1223** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben; Anthony, Calvin J.; States that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall have the power and duty to review and evaluate State Medicaid Program eligibility and enrollment guidelines in relation to federal regulations. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

## Executive Action – Signed

**HB1185** Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. (05/21/96)

**HB1268** Relates to environment and natural resources; provides regulations and restrictions relating to recycling facilities. Eng. Sen. Amend. strikes the title. (04/09/96)

**HB1434** Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996. (05/20/96)

**HB1555** Relates to state government; authorizes purchases of certain non-medical, assistive technology - related items by State Department of Rehabilitative Services without competitive bid requirements. (05/01/96)

**HB1817** Authorizes expenditures from certain funds for certain purposes and limits the salary of the Director of the Department of Central Services; exempts certain employees from the merit system of Personnel Administration. (03/26/96)

**HB1860** Relates to motor vehicles; doubles fines for speeding in construction zones. (04/29/96)

**HB1880** Clarifies language relating to the dental profession. Creates and sets qualifications for a Board of Dentistry which is granted powers to enforce regulations and set standards of professional responsibility over the dental profession. (03/06/96)

**HB1947** Modifies certain language and requirements relating to branch offices of banks and trust companies. (04/17/96)

**HB1989** Allows public trusts to purchase materials and equipment from state contracts through central services. Originally modified duties of the district court judge in issuing certain instructions relating to acquisition of lands by purchase, donation or condemnation. (04/30/96)

**HB2053** Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula. (05/21/96)

**HB2055** Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the mid-term funding formula for schools. (05/22/96)

**HB2056** Requires the Department of Corrections to provide a place within the walls of the state prison at McAlester so that members of the immediate family of any deceased victim of the defendant may witness the execution; requires the judge who presided at the trial and the chief of police of the municipality in which the crime occurred to witness the execution. (04/08/96)

**HB2065** Creates the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Act; modifies definition. (05/21/96)

**HB2072** Modifies language as it relates to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System. (04/09/96)

**HB2082** Designates the black swallowtail as the state butterfly of Oklahoma. (04/01/96)

**HB2084** Clarifies language as it relates to the selling of advertising in Oklahoma Today Magazine. (04/23/96)

**HB2086** Deletes population requirements for cities and towns as they relate to the adoption of written investment policies. (05/14/96)

**HB2087** Modifies references to the Oklahoma State Pension Commission. (04/08/96)

**HB2089** Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. (05/07/96)

**HB2100** Allows for retired members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, Capitol Patrol or Lake Patrol to purchase the sidearm and shotgun or rifle issued to them; allows for the cost of the weapon to be obtained by the State Purchasing Director. (05/16/96)

**HB2104** Authorizes the creation of a flag commemorating the April 19, 1995, bombing of the Murrah Federal Building. Further authorizes the selection by the Governor of which commemorative flag will be flown throughout the state the week of each year in which April 19th falls. (03/12/96)
