Requires an annual report and a certificate of need for home health care agencies. Stipulates conditions and actions prior to issuance of certificate of need. Provides process and conditions for opposition and specifies penalties to be charged with a misdemeanor and fined between \$100 and \$500.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Submitted To House
