**SB 911** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Defines "economically at-risk wells" to include any oil or natural gas producing property which produces 3 barrels or less of oil or 30,000 cubic feet of gas per day unless the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma oil exceeds \$20 calculated on an annual calendar year basis or the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma gas exceeds \$2.50 per Million British Thermal Units calculated on an annual calendar year basis.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

**SB 947** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Modifies procedures and provides for administrative fines and penalties for violations of the Alarm Industry Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 05/06/96, Called Up For Consideration, 05/06/96, CCR Adopted - Senate, 05/06/96, Fourth Reading - Senate, 05/06/96, Bill Passed - Senate, 05/06/96, CCR Submitted To House.

**SB 959** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Creates the Natural Gas Competitiveness Act of 1996; limits authority of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission as it relates to natural gas.; Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

**SB 974** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Leist, M. C. Requires transporters of waste, wastewater, or sludge to develop and maintain manifests.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

**SB 976** Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Erwin, Randall L. Promotes the goals of the Oklahoma Recycling Initiative; states ownership of recoverable materials; prohibits government units from restricting donations or sales of recoverable materials.; Emergency. 05/09/96, Called Up For Consideration, 05/09/96, CCR Adopted - Senate, 05/09/96, Fourth Reading - Senate, 05/09/96, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, 05/09/96, Signed & Transmitted To House, 05/09/96, CCR Submitted To House.

**SB 981** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Deletes weight limit provisions pertaining to vehicles delivering agricultural commodities weighed as a single draft.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Submitted To House

**SB 983** Principal Author(s): Langmacher, Ron; Price, Bruce CCS, sets standards for signs in business areas, authorizing rotating sign faces and setting length and frequency of rotation. Original bill version: Exempts churches and other non profit 501(c)(3) organizations from charging and collecting permit fees for on-premise outdoor advertising structures.; Emergency; 04/30/96, CCR Submitted To House

**SB 988** Principal Author(s): Dunegan, James H.; Stipe, Gene Requires Dept. of Transportation to issue permits for multi-state oversize and overweight vehicles. Designates specific routes for vehicles operating under such permits.; Emergency. 05/07/96, Governor Action - Veto.

**SB 989** Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private moneys to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements.; Emergency. 05/06/96, Called Up For Consideration, 05/06/96, CCR Adopted - Senate, 05/06/96, Fourth Reading - Senate, 05/06/96, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, 05/06/96, CCR Submitted To House.

**SB 993** Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

**SB 996** Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Stanley, Fred Requires voters to sign a precinct registry before being issued a ballot.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate
