SB 1106 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; prohibits the Board from offering a health plan which is owned or operated by the state and which utilizes a capitated payment plan for providers which uses a primary care physician as a gatekeeper to any specialty care provided by physician-specialists, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1111 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000.000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000.000. SB 1130 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1133 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Monson, Angela Exempts sales of tangible personal

property or services to certain organizations from sales taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 05/07/96, Governor Action - Signed.

SB 1150 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Lengthens amount of time needed before the arrested is brought before a court from 24 to 48 hours. Modifies procedures for an arresting peace officer and the subsequent actions that must be undertaken.; Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1152 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hefner, Jerry W. Creates the Substance Abuse Prevention Program. Provides guidelines for children in need of supervision or delinquent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1163 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Changes name of act of "Educational Deregulation Act" to "Oklahoma Trailblazer Schools and School Districts Act." Removes some requirements for eligibility for deregulation, states limits for deregulation, provides limitation of number of districts and school sites that may be deregulated.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1166 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Voskuhl, Sean Requires disclosure of actual payments if copayments are based on discounted or nondiscounted charges; requires explanation of benefits and copayments to clearly and accurately disclose actual amount paid or to be paid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate

SB 1167 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Steidley, Dwayne Provides regulations relating to simulcast races and fair associations licensed to conduct race meeting; clarifies days considered racing days. Provides for percentage of winnings to be received from wagering and provides for distribution of such moneys. SB 1177 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Provides that any license holder of a nursing home who has been cited more than three times for deficiencies which lead to enforcement action and penalties, or found to be out of substantial compliance with the requirements of any statute or rule, will not be deemed a person responsible or suitable to operate or direct such a facility.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 05/01/96, CCR Read By Senate
