HB2053 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

HB2055 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the mid-term funding formula for schools.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2086 Principal Author(s): Dunlap, James R.; Hendrick, Howard H. Deletes population requirements for cities and towns as they relate to the adoption of written investment policies.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB2115 Principal Author(s): Breckinridge, Flint; Smith, Jerry L. Modifies condition by which murder in the first degree occurs in certain circumstances.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB2179 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Thomas, Tommy Allows the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to accept federal grant money to augment programs within its jurisdiction to reimburse the state for any such assistance payments; allows the authority to make apportionments with said funds.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB2278 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben States minimum requirements for a second or subsequent drug and alcohol substance abuse course for those having had a related revocation or suspension; provides for criteria for offenders under the age of 21.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2291 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Lewis Jr. Clarifies language relevant to the suspension, demotion, or termination of education support employees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. HB2373 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2408 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Harrison, J. Berry Modifies language relating to Rural Water, Sewer, Gas, and Solid Waste Management Districts Act.; Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2470 Principal Author(s): Deutschendorf, Abe; Helton, Sam Creates the Oklahoma Prison Industry Marketing Development Advisory Task Force until July 1, 2001.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB2553 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Seikel, Mark Relates to the Agents Licensing Act; deletes surplus line insurance brokers from licensing requirements; adds fraternal agents to licensing requirements; modifies language and fees; modifies educational requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Reconsideration Motion Adopted - Senate

HB2584 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Requires approval by county commissioners of the sale by auction of properties acquired by the county under the provisions of the resale tax laws.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2620 Principal Author(s): Davis, Frank W.; Maddox, James R. Creates the Construction Division within the Department of Corrections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
