**HB1088** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Provides for the deduction from OK adjusted gross income any medical expenses incurred in the process of adoption of a minor.; Effective Date: 11/01/96; 04/30/96, CCR Submitted To House

**HB1127** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Kerr, Robert M. Relates to soldiers and sailors; removes the requirement that three of the nine members of the War Veterans Commission of Oklahoma be veterans of the

Vietnam Conflict; provides that the term "war veteran" shall apply to any honorably discharged person who served on active duty in any branch of the military or naval services of the United States during a period of war, campaign, or expedition in which the United States Participated, and were awarded service medals as authorized by the United States Department of Defense; makes exempt from licensing from the Director of the Wildlife Conservation Department those persons who are legal resident veterans having disability of 50% or more.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency; 05/25/95, Returned To Calendar - House
