**SB 1111** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000,000.
