**HB1185** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis, Jr., Thornbrugh, C. Michael. Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB1434** Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank. Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/17/96**

**HB2053** Principal Author(s) Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/15/96**

**HB2055** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don. Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the midterm funding formula for schools. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/17/96**

**HB2065** Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Hobson, Cal. Creates the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Act; modifies definition. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2182** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene. States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2379** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard. States that restricted driver's licenses shall become nonrenewable; provides conditions upon which restricted status may be removed. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2408** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Harrison, J. Berry. Modifies the language relating to Rural Water, Sewer, Gas and Solid Waste Management Districts Act. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2548** Principal Author(s): Modifies language relating to the Department of Human Services and claims or payroll. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2584** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Requires approval by county commissioners of the sale by auction of properties acquired by the county under the provisions of the resale tax law. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2642** Principal Author(s): Exempts the Sale of Oklahoma Magazine and production of merchandise for resale from the Central Purchasing Act; states that specified services for the production of Oklahoma Today magazines shall also be exempt from said act; extends petty cash fund usage to include the payment of bank charges and the purchasing of beverage and vending license. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2796** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Smith, Jerry L. Provides that recordable instruments shall be written and printed in English and presented in a certain manner. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**HB2824** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E., Haney Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal. Establishes appropriations to the State Board of Education for midterm supplements to State Aid to school districts from the Rainy Day Fund and makes other appropriations from the Rainy Day Fund. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/17/96**

**HB2830** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E., Haney Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne. Appropriates funds to the State Treasurer, Water Resources Board and Department of Transportation for the Rural Economic Action Program. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/17/96**

**HB2971** Principal Author(s): Clarifies language pertaining to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Distinguishes adopted children from biological children with regard to benefits. Defines beneficiary. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB74** Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Relates to runaway children; adds runaway child to crime of contributing to delinquency; defines runaway child; criminalizes harboring certain runaway children; provides penalty. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB680** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis, Jr.; Stottlemire, Gary. Prohibits bear wrestling exhibitions and horse tripping events; provides for punishment and fines for violation; allows the arresting law enforcement agency or animal control office to take custody of all animals in possession of the arrested person. Any person who commits any assault and battery against a current or former spouse, an individual with whom the

defendant has had a child, or former resident of the defendant's household shall be guilty of domestic abuse punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one year or a fine of \$2,000 or both; subsequent convictions may include two years imprisonment and \$5,000 fine or both. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB719** Principal Author(s): Rice, Larry; Weedn, Trish; Modifies the definition of 'record' as it relates to the Oklahoma Open Records Act to include data files created by or used with computer software; modifies statutory references; exempts the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from furnishing certain criminal history information. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB834** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne. Appropriates funds to the Department of Education for midterm adjustments from the General Revenue Fund. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB1270** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Satterfield, Shelby. Defines 'wireless telephone company' and 'other telephone service company' as it applies to the Nine-One-One Emergency Number Act. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

**SB1315** Principal Author(s): Directs purchasing specifications and parameters relating to OneNet. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/15/96**
