**SB 911** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Defines oil and gas - economically at-risk oil lease - exemption from gross production tax; codification and effective date.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Third CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 921** Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E.; Wilkerson, Dick Repeals various sections pertaining to sales and income taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 923** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Clarifies statutory references pertaining to the Firefighters Pension and Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Read - Senate

**SB 976** Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Erwin, Randall L. Promotes the goals of the Oklahoma Recycling Initiative; states ownership of recoverable materials; prohibits government units from restricting donations or sales of recoverable materials.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 989** Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private moneys to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**SB 993** Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale. Modifies duties of the Oklahoma Tax Commission and moto license agents; requires training of personnel authorized to perform inspections and examinations; modifies time at which certain fee required to be paid and modifies apportionment thereof; prohibiting suit against certain agencies and persons liable for certain acts; requires the Department of promulgate rules; provides an effective date and declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Failed - House, Motion To Reconsider - House, Reconsideration Motion Adopted - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate

**SB 996** Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Stanley, Fred Requires voters to sign a precinct registry before being issued a ballot.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1002** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Provides additional basis for the

issuance of a specified certificate from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1032** Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Littlefield, Rick Allows any eligible employer of a municipality which is a participating employer in the Oklahoma Public Employees Pension and Retirement System on July 1, 1996 to become a participating municipality of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System on Sept. 1 1996, only if certified copy of a resolution approved by the governing body of the eligible employer or by any other body or officer authorized by law or recognized by the State Board to approve such a resolution and assure that it is filed with the State Board by August 15, 1996. Such election shall be irrevocable. States additional eligibility requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Modifies list of prescription and non prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

**SB 1177** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Provides that any license holder of a nursing home who has been cited more than three times for deficiencies which lead to enforcement action and penalties, or found to be out of substantial compliance with the requirements of any statute or rule, will not be deemed a person responsible or suitable to operate or direct such a facility.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1225** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Adds definitions relating to environment and natural resources; expands jurisdiction of the Conservation Commission to include recipients of nonpoint pollution funds; states availability of the related revolving funds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

**SB 1293** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Steidley, Dwayne Creates the Oklahoma Civil Access to Justice Revolving Fund; increases certain court costs.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected,

Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**SB 1310** Principal Author(s): Shedrick, Bernice; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies statutory references relating to workers' compensation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

**SB 1320** Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill; Smith, Jerry L. Clarifies statutory references, merges duplicate sections of earlier passed legislation.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. General Order - House

**SCR 38** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Settle, Bill Authorizes the Board of Regents for Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges to issue revenue bonds on behalf of Connors State College.; CCR Adopted - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

**SCR 52** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Toure, Opio Authorizes the Board of Regents for the University of Oklahoma to issue certain revenue bonds pursuant to Section 4002.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and directing distribution.; House Committee - Do Pass, Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - House

**SCR 53** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Toure, Opio Expresses appreciation to the people of Iowa for demonstrating their support for Oklahoma; saluting Iowa on its 150th anniversary; directing distribution.; Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - House

**SCR 54** Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Kerr, Robert M.; Price, Bruce Memorializes the US Congress to enact laws or otherwise cause the IRS to provide relief for farmers regarding agricultural production deferral agreements and directing distribution.; House Amendments - Rejected, Referred To Conference Committee
