**SB1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William; States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members. **SB1177** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don; Williams, Penny; Provides that any license holder of a nursing home who has been cited more than three times for deficiencies which lead to enforcement action and penalties, or found to be out of substantial compliance with the requirements of any statute or rule, will not be deemed a person responsible or suitable to operate or direct such a facility. **SB1230** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura; Brown, Ben; Make it unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to operate a vehicle who has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.02 percent. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

**HB1088** Provides for the deduction from OK adjusted gross income any medical expenses incurred in the process of adoption of a minor. (05/23/96)

**HB1185** Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. (05/21/96)

**HB1268** Relates to environment and natural resources; provides regulations and restrictions relating to recycling facilities. Eng. Sen. Amend. strikes the title. (04/09/96)

**HB1434** Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996. (05/20/96)

**HB1555** Relates to state government; authorizes purchases of certain non-medical, assistive technology - related items by State Department of Rehabilitative Services without competitive bid requirements. (05/01/96)

**HB1621** Modifies language relating to income tax; allowing private sector employees to claim a tax exemption on benefits. (05/23/96)

**HB1770** Relates to regulation of energy production and distribution; makes appropriations to the Corporation Commission and the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board and making those appropriations subject to fiscal year limitations. (05/29/96)

**HB1777** Relates to the chief executive offices; makes appropriations to the offices of the governor and lieutenant governor. (05/23/96)

**HB1781** Relates to economic development and how it relates to fiscal planning for the Department of Commerce. Specifies expenditures, reports and audits. (05/29/96)

**HB1805** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enock Kelly; Makes appropriations to the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Rehabilitation and the Office of Juvenile Affairs. (05/28/96)

**HB1815** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James; Haney, Kelly; Makes appropriations to the Department of Central Services and to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority. (05/28/96)
