HB1238 Principal Author(s): Crocker, Ed; Easley, Kevin A. Relates to public finance; requires the disclosure of the identity of any public official or spouse that is an owner or operator or who is a principal of any legal entity which owns or operates a project or who has any financial interest, whether direct or indirect, in the project that no conflict of interest exists because of the public official's or any person who was public official during the immediately preceding 24 months; requires that a list of all political campaign contributions made in Oklahoma during the 48 months immediately preceding the submission of the application of all persons that will have a financial interest in the project.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Second CCR Rejected - Senate, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB1434 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

HB1621 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies language relating to income tax; allowing private sector employees to claim a tax exemption on benefits.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB1672 Principal Author(s): Toure, Opio Modifies definitions of terms in the Employment Security Act of 1980; provides conditions under which an employee cannot be disqualified for benefits.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

HB1777 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Relates to the chief executive offices; makes appropriations to the offices of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency. CCR Submitted To House

HB1787 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Relates to state revenue administration entities and makes certain appropriations to those entities.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency. CCR Submitted To House

HB1800 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Makes appropriations to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, the office of Handicapped Concerns, the Human Rights Commission, and the Indian Affairs Commission.; Effective Date: 07/01/95 Emergency. CCR Submitted To House

HB2059 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Long, Ed Creates the Oklahoma Tuition Savings Account Act; provides aid and assistance in financing for postsecondary education; defines terms; allows residents to contribute to a tuition savings account not to exceed \$5,000; allows for adjustments in the Oklahoma taxable income and the Oklahoma adjusted gross in-

come; provides for tax exemptions for contributions made after December 31, 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Adopt CCR, Third CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate

HB2143 Principal Author(s): Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996, to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council; recreates the Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA; creates the Advisory Commission on Latin American and Hispanic Affairs; stating legislative intent; provides for appointments and responsibilities; and codification.; . Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Adopt CCR, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HB2164 Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne; Williams, Penny Requires Oklahoma state higher education facilities to annually publish all tuition and fees free of charge to any person requesting any information relating to tuition or fees at that institution.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2193 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Allows school districts to create their own educational improvement plan; deletes required components of said plan; allows districts to request an exemption from any statutory requirement or State Board rule not related to bilingual and special education programs, health and safety provisions, school finance, State Aid, pupil formula weights, teacher salary and teacher retirement, the Oklahoma School Testing Program and the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Further Conference Granted

HB2271 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Emergency. Second CCR Rejected - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2362 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2374 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Monson, Angela Creates the Workplace and Employee Protection Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2483 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank Updates language pertaining to the powers of

the State Board of Agriculture.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Laid Over - Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

HB2512 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Transfers authority over the Oklahoma Office of Volunteerism from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; Creates the Oklahoma Commission on Volunteerism; directs the Office of the Secretary of State to provide staff support; states powers and duties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2541 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies requirements of nonlawyer judges as they relate to the filing of traffic violation reports with the Department of Public Safety; reduces number of hours of continuing legal education required from twelve (12) hours to six (6) hours; includes attendance of at least one (1) day of a state judicial conference from a judge; provides for verification of said attendance.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2642 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Exempts the sale of Oklahoma Magazine and production of merchandise for resale from the Central Purchasing Act; states that specified services for the production of Oklahoma Today magazine shall also be exempt from said act; extends petty cash fund usage to include the payment of bank charges and the purchasing of beverage and vending licenses.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

HB2647 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Amends title language relating to The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority providing funds for repairs to Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department properties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2648 Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Monson, Angela Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act; adding to coverage of rules and requiring certain disclosure. Requires application fee, with certain information from persons; requiring certain investigation and determination; provides for expiration of licensure; denial of licensure; revocation or suspension of license; specifying grounds and issuances of renewals; authorizes certain relief; making certain person civilly liable for certain damages; authorizes civil relief regardless of criminal prosecution; provides for other remedies; codification and effective date.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.
