HB2698 Principal Author(s): Ervin, Mike; Henry, Brad Allows the Department of Human Services to charge a service fee to those obliged to pay child support to cover administrative costs; states that such fees shall be deposited into the Child Support Revenue Enhancement Fund.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2701 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Satterfield, Shelby Modifies acceptable bell types for locomotives to include air horns.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2893 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; Settle, Bill Creates the Oklahoma Limited Liability Partnership Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2964 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes.; Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

HB2969 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96

HB3008 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Directs the Department of Corrections to not house or process inmates at the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in Oklahoma City. States that no inmate shall be allowed to enter or remain in the building or on the grounds of the building, unless the inmate is under the direct supervision of DOC personnel.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HCR1097 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Paulk, William R.; Perry, Fred; Weedn, Trish Directs all state agencies and state educational institutions to immediately remove from their computer systems all illegal obscene material and especially child pornography.; . Called Up For Consideration, Floor Substitute, Amendment Adopted - Senate, Signed & Returned To House

HCR1114 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; Hilliard, Danny; Ramsey, Dan; Robinson, Ben H. Congratulates the Oklahoma Association of Independent Insurance Agents.; . House Introduction And First Reading

SB 74 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Relates to runaway children; adds runaway child to crime of contributing to delinquency; defines runaway child; criminalizes harbouring certain runaway children; provides penalty.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 149 Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R.; Stipe, Gene Clarifies the name of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board as it pertains to water being turned into any natural or artificial watercourse.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 680 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Stottlemire, Gary Prohibits bear wrestling exhibitions and horse tripping events; provides for punishment and fines for violation; allows the arresting law enforcement agency or animal control office to take custody of all animals in possession of the arrested person. Any person who commits any assault and battery against a current or former spouse, an individual with whom the defendant has had a child, or former resident of the defendant's household shall be guilty of domestic abuse punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one year or a fine of \$3,000 or both. Subsequent convictions may include 2 years imprisonment and \$5,000 or both.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 720 Principal Author(s): Weedn, Trish; Wells, Dale W. Creates the Southern Regional Emergency Management Assistance Compact.; Emergency. Called

SB 854 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Ford, Charles R.; Williams, Penny Creates the Oklahoma Capitol Complex Centennial Commission; provides that beginning June 30, 1997, the Legislature should appropriate \$2.5 million annually for the next consecutive 10 years to fund the commission.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 921 Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E.; Wilkerson, Dick Repeals various sections pertaining to sales and income taxes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1002 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Provides additional basis for the issuance of a specified certificate from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Adopt CCR, Motion Failed - House, CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1031 Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Motion To Adopt CCR, Motion Failed - House, Second CCR Rejected - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1053 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Deletes all confidentiality and sealing requirements relating to juvenile records.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1071 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1080 Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Snyder, Mark Requires that a complete disclosure of name, mailing address and finding address of every stockholder with at least five percent ownership shall be included with each hospice license application.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate
