SB 1100 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don Directs property taxes of railroads and public service corporations shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and states that all others shall be paid to the appropriate county treasurer; states that such taxes paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be deposited into Protested Ad Valorem Tax Revolving Fund; removes due date for payment; replaces references to Head Start programs with language relating to free or reduced lunches as it relates to admission into early childhood programs; deletes specified contents of report to the governor; deletes probationary accreditation requirements; modifies authority of the State Department of Education; provides for emergency school transfers; modifies midterm funding; provides for pupil removal from class; creates the Oklahoma Accountability System; creates the Technology Endowment Fund; authorizes the State Board of Education to award Statewide Alternative Education Program Grants; directs the board to promulgate rules establishing the Oklahoma Advanced Placement Incentive Program; provides funding for teacher bonus programs; repeals sections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1123 Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies list of prescription and non prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Submitted To House, CCR Read - House

SB 1147 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Shedrick, Bernice Prohibits the use of accident reports for commercial purposes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 1184 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Kerr, Robert M. Creates the Alternative School Program providing, in addition to classroom instruction, 24 hour per day, 7 days per week supervision for certain juveniles.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1207 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Authorizes the Department of Human Services to give consent for medical examinations and tests and the release of test results to placement providers.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1209 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Modifies references relating to vehicle inspection fees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Laid Over - Senate

SB 1227 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Stanley, Fred Relating to state government; allowing certain entities to participate in the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance plans under certain circumstances; modifies group of retirees allowed to participate in the dental insurance plan; and provides for an effective date; declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

SB 1230 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben Makes it unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to operate a vehicle who has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.02 percent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1270 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Satterfield, Shelby Defines "wireless telephone company" and "other telephone service company" as it applies to the Nine-One-One Emergency Number Act.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1303 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Voskuhl, Sean Modifies membership of the Advisory Committee on Medical Care for Public Assistance Recipients.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SCR 49 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Stipe, Gene Authorizes the Commission for Human Services to enter into a lease / purchase agreement for office space in Pittsburg County.; . Amendment Adopted - Senate

SCR 54 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Kerr, Robert M.; Price, Bruce Memorializes the US Congress to enact laws or otherwise cause the IRS to provide relief for farmers regarding agricultural production deferral agreements and directing distribution.; . House Committee - Do Pass As Amended

SCR 60 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the president of the United States to direct the federal government to investigate the domestic cattle market.; . House Committee - Do Pass

SCR 65 Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Smith, Jerry L. Praises the life and achievements of the late Joseph Lewis "Jody" Latimer; honoring his memory.; . SCR 66 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene Authorizes the Board of Regents of Eastern Oklahoma State College acting on behalf of the Eastern Oklahoma State College to issue certain revenue bonds.; . Referred Direct To Calendar, Adopted - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House

HB1185 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis, Jr.; Thornbrugh, C. Michael. Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

HB2053 Principal Author(s) Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treat-

ment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/15/96**

HB2055 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don. Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the midterm funding formula for schools. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/17/96**

HB2065 Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Hobson, Cal. Creates the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Act; modifies definition. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

HB2182 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene. States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - 05/16/96**

HB2379 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard. States that restricted driver's licenses shall
