SB 685 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Leftwich, Keith Sets maximum speed and minimum speed limits for interstate and four-lane divided highways.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Reject CCR, Motion To Table, Motion Failed - Senate, CCR Rejected, Motion Adopted - Senate, Further Conference Granted, Further Conference Requested

SB 702 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Provides penalties for any person selling low-point beer between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 730 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Fisher, Ted V. Modifies language and statutory references relating to assessment and valuation of property; requires county assessors to assess specified improvements based on fair market value.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 777 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Provides for the reimbursement for persons engaging in voluntary cleanup programs.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 791 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Roberts, Darryl F.; Williams, Don Removes the prohibition against transporting a concealed rifle or shotgun in a vehicle.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 836 Principal Author(s): Ervin, Mike; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from the Cash Flow Reserve Fund.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 843 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds to the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, providing budgetary limitations, providing for duties and compensation of employees, limits the salary of the director, authorizes and provides budgeting of certain monies.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 847 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds to the Commission on Consumer

Credit; provides budgetary limitations; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limits the salary of the director; authorizing and providing budgeting of certain monies.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 871 Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R.; Helton, Sam States that the governing body of a municipality may authorize the CEO of the municipality to respond to any request from any other jurisdiction within one state for law enforcement assistance in cases of emergency.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 891 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Provides additional years of participating service for employees terminated due to a reduction in force due to privatization or loss of federal revenue.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 974 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Leist, M. C. Requires transporters of waste, wastewater, or sludge to develop and maintain manifests.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1031 Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Second CCR Submitted To House

SB 1050 Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Stanley, Fred Modifies language relating to firearms.; Emergency. Second CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 1077 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale W. Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of Department of Central Services, and boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

SB 1082 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish Grants authority for certain part time employment within specified cities and towns by off duty police officers.; Emergency. Further Conference Granted

SB 1101 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Deletes fee remittance requirement relating to payment of removal fees to the state for motor vehicles.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1166 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Voskuhl, Sean Requires disclosure of actual payments if copayments are based on discounted or nondiscounted charges; requires explanation of benefits and copayments to clearly and accurately disclose actual amount paid or to be paid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1167 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Steidley, Dwayne Provides regulations relating to simulcast races and fair associations licensed to conduct race meeting; clarifies days considered racing days. Provides for percentage of winnings to be received from wagering and provides for distribution of such moneys. States Oklahoma does not conduct live racing.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1185 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. Allows for destruction or donation of certain court records that have been microfilmed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1315 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Directs purchasing specifications and parameters relating to OneNet.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate
