HB2362 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred; Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

HB2403 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry; Steidley, Dwayne; Modifies deposits to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund to allocate 25 percent of each deposit as follows: ¾ to the AG Evidence Fund and ¼ to the AG Revolving Fund. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

HB2445 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin; Voskuhl, Sean; Develops extended area telephone service and wide area calling plans where arbitrary boundaries divide communities and school districts. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/29/96)

HB2463 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Dunegan, James H. Modifies date to 1997 relating to required FTE recommendations from the Human Resources Management Advisory Committee. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR (05/28/96)

HB2466 - Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed; Amends language relating to a teacher's right to due process and compensation or benefits when a board of education receives a superintendent's recommendation for a teacher's dismissal unless the career teacher is convicted of a felony. HB2497 - Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H.; Deletes obsolete language pertaining to the Oklahoma State Employees Benefit Council. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2647 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Amends title language relating to The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority providing funds for repairs to Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department properties. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/29/96).

HB2648 Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill; Monson, Angela; Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act; adding to coverage of rules and requiring certain disclosure. Requires application fee, with certain information from persons; requiring certain investigation and determination; provides for expiration of licensure; denial of licensure; revocation or suspension of license; specifying grounds and issuance's of renewals; authorizes certain relief; making certain person civilly liable for certain damages; authorizes civil relief regardless of criminal prosecution; provides for other remedies; codification and effective date. HB2812 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Hendrick, Howard; Defines the term electric assisted bicycle; provides considerations under which electric assisted bicycles may be operated including requirements for operator licenses, liability insurance, and safety equipment. HB2821 - Principal Author(s) Hamilton James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne; Relates to general appropriations for the expenses of various agencies of the executive, legislative, and judicial departments of the state. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2823 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne; Provides midterm supplements to the State Board of Education State Aid to education for the 1995-96 school year. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2832 - Principal Author(s): Sets the maximum number of full-time employees for various state agencies and the maximum salaries for each office. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2837 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne; Sets appropriations to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the fulfillment of the duties imposed upon the department by law. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2840 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne; Regulates appropriations to the Office of Juvenile Affairs from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2874 - Principal Author(s): Rice, Larry; Easley, Kevin; Modifies definitions to include natural gas; increases the membership of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board from eighteen to thirty-one; decreases membership of said board to twenty-seven after July 1, 1996 and provide for reapportionment of members. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2938 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James; Dickerson, Larry; Clarifies language to the Oklahoma Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Act. Allows the Attorney General to recover costs and expenses of litigation and attorney fees for representation relating to the environment and natural resources. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2959 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce; Provides tax credit against taxes imposed for direct investments by agricultural cooperative marketing associations in agricultural joint ventures created and designed to develop and advance the production, processing, handling and marketing of agricultural commodities grown, made or manufactured in Oklahoma. HB2960 - Principal Author(s) Seikel, Mark; Weedn, Trish; Directs DHS to cooperate with and help promote foster parent associations in each county; provide additional services relating to the placement of children in foster care; develop a policy of accident, personal liability and automobile liability insurance; and develop a procedure to determine the ability of parents to pay part or all of the costs for foster care. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2964 Principal Author(s) Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark. Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes. HB2969 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark; Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid. HB2972 - Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny; Creates the Oklahoma Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment Act. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

HB2975 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ. Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

HB2981 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave. Provides for the establishment of the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners, the election of the members, and the duties of the position. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).
