SB989 - Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray; Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private moneys to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB996 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl; Stanley, Fred; Requires voters to sign a precinct registry before being issued a ballot. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/29/96)

SB1002 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin; Robinson, Ben; Provides additional basis for the issuance of a specified certificate from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/29/96)

SB1024 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Price, Bruce. Provides for Oklahoma Department of Commerce support of international trade relationships. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1031 - Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al; Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1032 Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Littlefield, Rick. Allows any eligible employer of a municipality which is a participating employer in the Oklahoma Public Employees Pension and Retirement System on July 1, 1996 to become a participating municipality of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System on Sept. 1, 1996, only if certified copy of a resolution approved by the governing body of the eligible employer or by any other body or officer authorized by law or recognized by the State Board to approve such a resolution and assure that it is filed with the State Board by August 15, 1996. Such election shall be irrevocable. States additional eligibility requirements. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1077 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale; Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of the Department of Central Services, and boards of education. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

SB1087 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne. Makes \$40.00 per month fee for persons with a deferred prosecution program supervised by the Probation and Parole Division of the Department of Corrections. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1100 Principal Author (s): Anthony, Calvin, J.; Williams, Don; Initiates comprehensive education reform. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1111 - Principal Author(s): Price, Bruce; Sadler, Al; Modifies estate tax deductions. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1122 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben; Authorizes municipalities to prosecute minor for violating firearms ordinances. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

SB1123 Principal Author(s): Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Modifies list of prescription and non-prescription drugs to be included under Section IV and Section II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1130 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William; States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

SB1166 Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Voskuhl, Sean. Requires disclosure of actual payments if copayments are based on discounted or nondiscounted charges; requires explanation of benefits and copayments to clearly and accurately disclose actual amount paid or to be paid. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1177 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don; Williams, Penny; Provides that any license holder of a nursing home who has been cited more than three times for deficiencies which lead to enforcement action and penalties, or found to be out of substantial compliance with the requirements of any statute or rule, will not be deemed a person responsible or suitable to operate or direct such a facility. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/29/96)

SB1209 - Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don; Williams, Penny; Modifies references relating to vehicle inspection fees. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1215 - Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hutchison, Joe J.; States that no person shall operate any vessel on any water in the state while under the influence of any substance listed in the Uniformed Controlled Substances Act or any combination of alcohol and said substance; authorizes the Grand River Dam Authority to set maximum lake speed limits; states that no person shall operate any vessel on any water of the state, except those that are privately owned, at speeds in excess of those established. SB1227 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Stanley, Fred. Relating to state government; allowing certain entities to participate in the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance plans under certain circumstances; modifies group of retirees allowed to participate in the dental insurance plan; and provides for an effective date; declares an emergency. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1230 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura; Brown, Ben; Make it unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to operate a vehicle who has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.02 percent. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/28/96)

SB1252 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne. Appropriates funds and sets budgetary limitations for Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1253 - Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne; Appropriates funds and sets budgetary limitations for the State Supreme Court. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/31/96)

SB1254 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne. Appropriates funds and sets budgetary limitations for Oklahoma Department of Labor. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1261 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne. Civil procedure. Requiring certain form of pleading for certain transferred action; providing for service by mail to garnishee; providing for service of summons' providing for notice for termination of lease agreement. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).

SB1294 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne. Exempts from jury service persons who have previously served within the previous two years. SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/30/96).
