**HB1434** Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2100** Principal Author(s): Rice, Larry; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for retired members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, Capitol Patrol or Lake Patrol to purchase the sidearm and shotgun or rifle issued to them; allows for the cost of the weapon to be obtained by the State Purchasing Director.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2101** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Capps, Gilmer N.; Ferguson, Larry R. Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of education of a municipality with a population of over 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2170** Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Shurden, Frank Changes quail season hunting dates to the first Saturday in November to January 31.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. Motion To Table, Motion Pre-vailed - House, Enrolled - House

**HB2172** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M.; Maddox, James R. Modifies Oklahoma Pawnshop Act. Prohibits issuing a license for a location within a county with a population of less than 11,000 or in counties of more than 11,000 population when there is an active pawnshop license for every 11,000 or fraction thereof of the population.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2188** Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan; Hendrick, Howard H. Modifies the definition of "medical savings account" to include that which is offered by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; allows any funds remaining in a medical savings account at the end of a tax year to remain in the account for future medical expenses; provides for payment of account funds to the account holder in the event the employee is no longer employed; also provides for an option to retain the account after employment; also allows for transfer of account to a new employer without penalty; requires the board to offer a high deductible health benefit plan; provides employees participating in a deferred compensation plan the option of transferring those funds to a medical savings account.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2271** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2279** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben Exempts persons over the age of sixty-five (65) from paying a fee for a traffic record summary furnished by the Department of Public Safety or a motor license agent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2294** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes Wildlife Conservation to sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material it produces.; Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2323** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Smith, Dale Creates the "School District Budget Act."; Ef-

fective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2348** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Provides coverage requirement for health benefit plans as they relate to maternity coverage.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2362** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2373** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

**HB2379** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard H. States that restricted driver's licenses shall become nonrenewable; provides conditions upon which restricted status may be removed.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2483** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank Updates language pertaining to the powers of the State Board of Agriculture.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2692** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Fisher, Ted V. Places the Juvenile Justice Advisory and
