Oversight Committee under the supervision of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; states that the amount of a juvenile's earnings designated for restitution to victims shall be placed in the Juvenile Restitution Revolving Fund; states that acquisitions or purchases of clothing for juveniles or acquisitions of food for group homes under the custody of the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; expands provisional scope to include purchases from such funds received by offices administered by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. SB 587 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Paulk, William R. Includes advanced practice nurses in list of medical practitioners included in definition of prescription; includes advanced practice nurses in definition of licensed practitioner; specifies that advanced

registered nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse-midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetist, and advanced practice nurses such nurses may not dispense drugs but may dispense professional samples; allows such nurses to diagnose, prescribe, distribute, and administer medicines, devices, or treatments as defined by the Board of Nursing; requires such nurses practitioners to accept responsibility to practice in accepted manner for their profession.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
