| Section 1. | Appropriates \$558,079. |
| Section 2. | Appropriates \$180,000 for the purpose of funding the Oil and Gas career ladder. |
| Section 3. | Sets salary limits on certain positions. |
| Section 4. | Expresses intent that \$120,000 be spent on Tulsa office operations. |
| Section 5. | Expresses intent that no more than \$500,000 be spent on well plugging activities. |
| Section 6. | Expresses intent that \$100,000 be spent on pollution response. |
| Section 7. | Sets the FTE limit at 453.0 and the lease-purchase limit at \$250,000. |
| Section 8. | Sets program budget limits. |
| Section 9. | Makes certain FTE contingent on funding. |
| Section 10. | Sets minimum FTE requirements for certain programs. |
| Section 11. | Sets a maximum expenditure limit on the Public Utility Division. |
| Section 12. | Provides for budget category limits. |
| Section 13. | Provides an effective date. |
